GRUMBLING is not greatness! (Num 14:1-4)

➤ Greater things are accomplished when great CHALLENGES are met by great FAITH.

1Thess 5:24; Php 1:6

Num 14:8 If the LORD is pleased with us, he will lead us into that land, a land flowing with milk and honey, and will give it to us."

Num 14:9 "Do not be afraid of the people of the land, because we will swallow them up. Their protection is gone, but the LORD is with us."
