TALK IT OVER

Talking through the message during the week can really help clarify the things that God is teaching you and let others learn from your experiences. Get with someone this week and talk about your answers to the following questions:

How have you helped others make peace in conflict? What does it mean *to make the peace of Christ your number one priority* (Col 3:15)? Describe a time when you either did so, or observed someone living out this principle?

What opportunities have you had recently to share the peace of God with someone far from Him? What big ideas stand out to you in 2Cor 5:17-18?

How can you allow Matt 5:9 be your guide in conflict more often?

What is God teaching you about being a peacemaker?



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God has given us the ability to BRING peace TO OTHERS:

We can bring God's peace to OUR RELATIONSHIPS. Ro 12:18

- > Try PRAYING for them FOR A WHILE. Matt 5:44
- > Then, try WORKING IT OUT. Matt 5:23-24
- > Try being a little LESS FRAGILE. Ps 119:165

We can bring God's peace to CONFLICT BETWEEN OTHERS. Heb 12:15

Make bringing God's peace to the conflict your NUMBER ONE PRIORITY. Col 3:15

We can bring God's peace to those FAR FROM GOD. 2Cor 5:17-18

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
