Do it ONCE. Do it RIGHT.

The reality is...

We get A LOT OF THINGS WRONG.

"I urge Euodia and I urge Syntyche to <u>BE OF THE SAME MIND</u> in the Lord. Yes, and I ask you also, my loyal companion, help these women, for they have struggled beside me in the work of the gospel, together with Clement and the rest of my co-workers, whose names are in the book of life." — Phil. 4:2-3 (cf. Phil. 2:2; 2:5; 3:15)

What prevents us from getting things right?

Our PRIORITIES are often formed by our PRIDE. Phil. 3:16-19; 1 John 4:7-17

Our <u>PRIDE</u> often reinforces our <u>PERCEPTION</u>. Contrast w/ Phil. 3:20-4:3; Gal. 5:16-21

How does God empower and entrust us to make things right?

He provides us with <u>PERSPECTIVE AFTER WE COME TO HIM</u> <u>WITH PRAYER</u>. Phil. 4:4-7; 1 Thess. 5:12-24; Luke 11:5-13; James 5:16

He provides us with <u>PEACE AFTER WE CONSISTENTLY PURSUE IT.</u> Phil. 4:8-9; Matt. 5:1-11; John 14:15-27; Rom. 15:1-13

If you want to enjoy life...

- DON'T IGNORE THE DIFFICULT THING that God is calling you to do.
- Continue to remember the <u>GRACE OF GOD FOR ALL YOU'VE GOTTEN WRONG</u>. 1 Peter 4:7-11; 2 Peter 1:3-15
