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Nippers Location

The first two sessions will be held at on the beach in front of the playground (Robinson Reserve) so Nippers can build their confidence in the water. All other sessions will be at Birubi Beach. If weather or tide conditions are not in our favour at Birubi we have the option to move Nippers to Boat Harbour. Notification will be around 4pm on the Saturday evening before Nippers and will be communicated via Facebook and Email/SMS.

Beach Set Up Duty

Parent assistance is required.

- On your age group's nominated date this involves packing the trailer with all the required equipment from the club house.
- Once the equipment is on the beach it involves lying out the boards, setting up flag races and running tracks etc. Please arrive at 8.10am for the beach set up duty.

Beach Pack Up Duty

Parent assistance is required.

- On your age group's nominated date this involves packing up all our equipment on the beach into the trailer.
- When the trailer returns to the club house it involves hosing down all the equipment and packing it away.

Note – on a beach day at Boat Harbour you don't need to go to the Surf Club it will just be done at the beach.

What To Bring Each Week To Nippers

We highly recommend setting up each child with their own flexible tub to keep their belongings in. We suggest the following items.

- Nipper cap – with child's name written or embroidered on each side.
- Nippers pink rashie shirt.
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Goggles
- Towel
- Wetsuit – Optional for cooler mornings.

Photography

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What To Expect Each Week

- Please arrive 5-10mins early to sign your child in on the attendance folder. There will be a table and tent set up each week on the beach with a clipboard folder for each age group.
- Once you are signed please add your child's water bottle and swimming goggles (if using) to their age number tub then sit in the marked area for your age group.
- The session starts with a group introduction and then each age group will go with their Age Manager and rotate through the set activities. These include running races and games, flag races and games, swimming or wading in the surf, using boards.
- The older groups will also learn to perform board and tube rescues. Nippers will also be taught beach signals and basic first aid information.

Club Facilities

The club house facilities are there **for everyone to use**. After nippers you can use the bathroom's for changing and warm showers. It's our responsibility to keep our facilities clean and tidy so we please ask you to hose off your sandy feet before coming inside the club house.

Parent Helpers

We love parent helpers. For the more dedicated helpers please consider participating in the Surf Rescue Certificate or Bronze Medallion award being run this year just after nippers every Sunday.

Particularly with the younger age groups, parents might need to be of assistance and go into the water. We suggest you wear appropriate clothing to get wet in.

Pink Rash Shirts/Singlets

Pink rash shirts and singlets from last year can be used again this year.

If you have outgrown your singlet, we are happy to have it returned so we can gift this to another nipper or keep it in our spare's kit.

This year we will be recording children's sizes at the water skills test and handing out rashies to new families at the pool on the water skills test day. This is to help us ensure we have enough sizes to go around.

Colour Nipper Caps

Coloured Caps are mandatory. For all returning kids, the coloured cap you wore last season will be the coloured cap you will wear this season.

For any new members, fees apply to purchase the cap for the respective age group.

Please ensure that once every child has finished their activities on each weekend, their cap is removed should they wish to go for a swim.

Club Championship

There are three competition rounds for all age groups. These are marked on the calendar as Points Days. The top scoring person in each group will be awarded Age Champion and the second highest scoring person will be awarded Age Runner-up. Events will include a running race, flags race, swim, and board race for older age groups. There are both Male and Female awards. Points are awarded as 1st 6 points, 2nd 5 points, 3rd 4 points, 4th 3 points, 5th 2 points, 6th 1 point. These awards will be presented on the presentation evening.

The dates may change if beach conditions are not suitable on the planned date. If there is any change to the Club Championships Day, notification will be via Facebook and Email/SMS. To be eligible for Age Champion/Runner Up, each Nipper must attend at least 12 sessions. 1 point for attendance will be awarded this season per week, so don't miss a session.

Other Awards

Each year Age Managers will also assign other awards that will be determined throughout the season. These awards are also presented on the presentation evening. Examples of these awards are most improved, encouragement award, most consistent, club spirit, team player etc.

Carnivals

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Water Skills Test

The water skills test will be conducted at the Tomaree Pool. Preliminary Evaluations are required to be completed prior to starting nippers each year. This is not a proficiency process, but a skills evaluation to enable clubs to determine the level of water safety to provide for participants.

The below is a guideline of the skills requirement for each age group.
