Max's South Seas Hideaway

Parking and Exterior Lighting.

Metered on-street parallel-style parking is available near the venue. No designated accessible spaces are present. The area is lit by standard street lamps. There is a nearby intersection with curb ramps present up onto the sidewalk. The crosswalks are marked.

The Weston – Commerce Ramp is a gated parking ramp. The parking ramp is northeast of the building, at 30 Weston Street SW. There is a driveway entrance and exit along Weston Street SW. There is a street entrance to the parking ramp along Commerce across the street from Stella's Lounge. This entrance is indicated with a "P" sign mounted over the push-button activated power door. There are designated accessible parking spaces and van accessible parking spaces with adjacent access aisles present.

Main Entrance and Accessibility.

Max's South Seas Hideaway is a themed bar & restaurant in the southwest Downtown Grand Rapids area.

The entrance is along Ionia Avenue SW. The entrance has a stoop with a step up from the sidewalk. Staff can be notified of your visit beforehand, and can secure a modular ramp to the stoop to provide stepless access into the venue. There is a non-powered door push/pull door present. The entrance opens into a reception area where guests can wait to be seated.

Interior Layout and Navigation.

The venue has three levels. The dining rooms are split between the first floor and the second level. Access to the basement and the second level is by stairs and an elevator.

The first floor dining room has armchair and sofa, low table with chair, high table with stool, and booth seating options available. The booths are flush with the floor. There is also high bar with stool seating available. There is no lowered section of counter present.

The second floor dining room has low table with chair, and booth seating options available. There is also high bar with stool seating available. There is no lowered section of counter present.



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Lighting and Atmosphere.

The barroom is kept dimly-lit, with small pockets of brighter illumination.

The venue has high ceilings.

The venue is generally quiet, but noise levels may become elevated during peak hours.

The venue has hardwood floors.

Restrooms.

There are unisex single-user restrooms available on the second floor. The interiors are spacious. There are grab bars around the toilets. The toilets and sinks are manually operated.
