Parking and Exterior Lighting.

Metered on-street parallel-style parking is available around the venue. No designated accessible spaces are present, but the spaces along Jefferson Avenue have an adjacent bike lane as a buffer against street traffic. The area is lit by standard street lamps. There is a nearby intersection with curb ramps present up onto the sidewalk. The crosswalks are marked.

Main Entrance and Accessibility.

One Stop Coney Shop is a restaurant in the center of the Downtown Grand Rapids area.

The entrance is along Fulton Street E. The entrance has a shallow slope up from the sidewalk. There is a non-powered door push/pull door present. The entrance opens directly into the dining room.

Interior Layout and Navigation.

The venue has a single level.

The dining room has low table with chair, and high bar with stool seating options available. There is no lowered section of bar counter present.

The ordering/pickup counter is lowered.

The routes between the tables are mostly wide. The bar counter with stool seating runs along the route to the restrooms, and the route may be narrow if patrons are sitting along the bar.

Lighting and Atmosphere.

The barroom is well-lit, primarily by natural light from large windows in the front of the venue.

The venue has high ceilings.

The venue is moderately quiet, but noise levels may become elevated during peak hours.



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The venue plays moderate volume background music.

The venue has hardwood floors.

Restrooms.

There is a unisex single-user restroom available in the back hall. The interior is spacious. There are grab bars around the toilets. The toilets and sinks are manually operated.
