Parking and Exterior Lighting.

Metered on-street parallel-style parking is available in front of the venue. No designated accessible parking spaces are present. The road is brick. The area is lit by standard street lamps. There is a nearby intersection with curb ramps present up onto the sidewalks. The crosswalks are marked.

Main Entrance and Accessibility.

The front entrance has manual push/pull doors. The entrance has a stoop, with a step up from the sidewalk in front of the venue.

The side entrance has manual push/pull doors. The entrance is flush with the pavement of the outdoor dining patio adjacent to the venue.

Interior Layout and Navigation.

The venue has a single level.

The venue has open plan, with a wide routes through the barroom.

The barroom has low table with chair, and low booth with chair seating options available. The booths are flush with the floor. There is high bar with stool seating available.

The outdoor dining patio has low table with bench, and high table with stool seating available.



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Lighting and Atmosphere.

The venue is well-lit, primarily by natural light from large windows.

The venue has high ceilings.

The venue is generally quiet, but noise levels may become elevated during peak hours.

The venue has tile floors.

Restrooms.

There are men's and women's multi-user restrooms. There are full-sized accessible stalls available. Grab bars are around the toilet.
