Parking.

Metered on-street parking lines Louis Street, with curb cuts at each intersection for smooth sidewalk access. Guests looking for a ramp with accessible spaces can use the Monroe Center Ramp directly across the street.

Entrances.

The primary entrance—located at the west corner of Louis Street and Ionia Avenue—features two sets of outward-swinging glass double doors that form a short vestibule, all flush with the sidewalk for easy roll-in access. A secondary interior door up a few steps from the CWD Building lobby is available, but most visitors will find the level street entrance the simplest option.

Inside / Getting Around.

The branch is a single level with wide aisles between street-facing cubicles and an interior wall with ATMs and several teller windows. A raised paperwork station and seating area line the middle. Pathways remain clear for mobility devices.

Sensory.

Overhead and indirect office lighting combine with generous front-window daylight to keep the space bright without glare. Noise stays at typical bank levels—quiet conversations and occasional transaction sounds—making communication easy.

Restrooms.

No public restrooms are available inside the branch; visitors may wish to use nearby facilities before or after banking.
