Parking and Exterior Lighting.

The Midtown Ellis Parking Ramp is a gated parking garage. The parking garage is north of the building, at 130 Lyon Street NW. There is a driveway entrance and exit along Lyon Street NW. There are designated accessible parking spaces with adjacent access aisles present. There are van accessible spaces available.

Main Entrance and Accessibility.

The Chop Shop is restaurant in northwest Downtown Grand Rapids area.



The entrance is along Monroe Avenue NW. There is a non-powered door push/pull door present, with a vestibule. The entrance is flush with the dining patio.

Interior Layout and Navigation.

The venue has two levels. The dining rooms split between the first floor and the basement level. An elevator provides access between each level.

The barroom has low table with chair, high table with stool, and booth seating options available. The booths are flush with the floor. There is also high bar with stool seating available. There is no lowered section of counter present.

Lighting and Atmosphere.

The barroom is moderately-lit, with natural light from large windows in front of the venue.

The venue has high ceilings.

The venue is generally quiet, but noise levels may become elevated during peak hours.

The venue has hardwood and low-pile carpet floors.



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Restrooms.

There are men's and women's multi-user restrooms available on the basement level. There are full-sized accessible stalls available. The toilets have grab bars. The toilets are automatically operated. The sinks are manually operated.
