Parking.

Limited metered on-street parking is available directly along Monroe Center. Nearby parking ramps and surface lots provide additional options, though some may require payment. The surrounding area is equipped with standard city streetlights that offer adequate visibility during evening hours.

Entrance.

The main public entrance is located on Monroe Center and features double manual wooden swing doors that open outward. These doors are flush with the sidewalk for easy access. A sidewalk sandwich board is placed off to the side near the windows, which does not pose a barrier but may reduce space slightly.

Interior Layout.

Upon entry, guests step onto a plush rug before reaching the service counter, which does not feature a lowered section and may be slightly high for some individuals. The interior is a single-level space with tiled flooring.



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To the right of the entrance, near the windows, there is a waiting area with a cushioned couch, standard-height chairs, a small coffee table, and a coat rack. Along the left-hand wall are manicure stations featuring standard-height chairs with back support, placed in front of tables and shelving that displays nail polish options. Pillars are present throughout the space but do not obstruct navigation and can be easily moved around.

On the right side of the space are the pedicure stations, featuring elevated spa chairs with footbaths. Nearby is a nail drying station, which has plastic seating. The space is well-lit with a mix of natural light from the windows and bright white-hued overhead lighting.

Sensory Notes.

The environment was quiet at the time of visit, but the volume level may increase during peak hours with more guests and background music.

Restroom.

There is one single-user, all-gender restroom located near the main lobby. It features a wider manual swinging door with accessible signage in raised characters and braille. Inside, the restroom offers adequate turning space, grab bars, and a manual sink with clear knee



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space underneath. Just outside the restroom, a water fountain is mounted on the wall.
