Parking.

Parking for Grand Action 2.0 is available along Ottawa Avenue through metered, on-street spaces. No dedicated accessible parking was observed nearby, though the surrounding sidewalks include curb cuts at the corners and crosswalks. Lighting in the area is provided by standard city street lamps, offering moderate visibility in the evening or early morning hours. No ramps or designated drop-off zones were present at the time of the visit.

Entrances.

There is one main entrance to the Grand Action 2.0 office, located directly off Ottawa Avenue. The entry features a manual swinging door that is flush with the sidewalk and leads into a small vestibule. Inside the vestibule is a step with a railing, which leads to another manual swinging door that provides access to the main office space. Although the outer door is at ground level, the presence of an interior step presents a potential barrier for visitors using mobility



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devices. No alternative or clearly labeled accessible entrances were observed.



Inside / Getting Around.

The office appears to be located on a single level. Upon entering, visitors will find a reception-like space with standard office chairs and couch-style seating available. The layout is simple and open, with no visible obstacles or abrupt changes in floor height within the main area. Navigation throughout the space appears to be straightforward, though full access could not be assessed beyond the

main seating area.

Lighting & Sensory Environment.

Overhead lighting is provided by white-hued ceiling fixtures, creating a well-lit but not overly bright atmosphere. Natural light was not a significant source of illumination during the visit. The overall environment was quiet, and while visitor traffic may vary, it is unlikely that the space becomes overly loud under normal conditions.

Restrooms.

No restrooms were visible or made available for review during the



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visit. It is unclear whether restroom facilities exist within the suite or elsewhere in the building for guest use.
