Parking.

Metered on-street parking is available directly along Weston Street. There are no designated accessible parking spaces or ramps nearby, but curb cuts at the corners allow smooth sidewalk access. No gate arms, lighting upgrades, or EV charging options are present in the immediate vicinity.

Entrances.

The main entrance is located off Weston Street and features a wood and glass manual door that opens outward. The threshold is flush with the sidewalk, allowing direct entry without the need for a ramp. There are no alternate entrances or powered doors, but the entry width is standard and navigable.

Inside / Getting Around.

The store is arranged in a single-level layout. Straight ahead from the entrance is the apparel section with racks of clothing and wall displays of shoes. The middle of the shop includes a fitting room. The fitting room is a tight squeeze and may not be easy to navigate with larger mobility devices. The right side of the shop is dedicated to skateboards and related gear. Toward the rear, the service counter features a lowered section for accessible transactions. Aisles are generally wide, though they can become congested during busy shopping hours.

Sensory.

Bright overhead lighting keeps the space well-lit. Moderate-volume music plays in the background, consistent with a typical skate shop vibe. No strong odors, strobe effects, or intense sensory elements are present.

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Restrooms.

No public restrooms are available on-site.

Additional Notes.

The layout is intuitive and mostly accessible, with open walkways, clear signage, and an approachable counter setup. While it can become tight during peak shopping hours, most visitors using mobility devices will find it possible to navigate with care. Staff are typically present at the counter and may assist with access or movement around displays if needed.
