Bridge Street Market (Last Updated July 2024)

The Bridge Street Market Parking Ramp is a gated parking ramp attached to the venue. There is a driveway entrance and exit along Seward Avenue NW. There are designated accessible parking spaces with an adjacent access aisle present. The van-accessible parking space has aisles on both sides. There are no EV charging stations present.

Entrances.

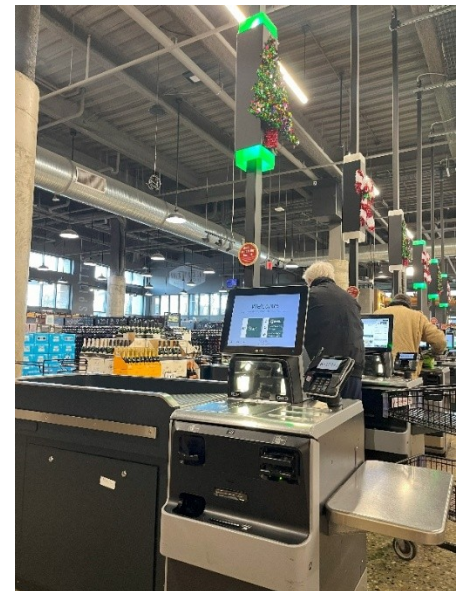
There are two entrances. The Main Entrance at the corner of Bridge Street and Seward Avenue has a proximity activated powered sliding door with stairs. The Parking Ramp entrance has multiple proximity activated powered sliding doors.

Getting Around.

The Bridge Street Market is a grocery store with high ceilings and tall windows overlooking Bridge Street.

The Checkout Counters are lowered. Voice prompts are provided at the check-out control panels.

There are men's and women's multi-user style restrooms with designated accessible stalls present, near the Checkout Counters. The toilets and sinks are automated.



The Café has lowered counters. There is a small dining area with table and chair seating options.

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The aisles between the displays are wide and generally kept clear.

The refrigerator displays have lightweight, transparent swinging doors.
