Mosby's Popcorn (last updated May 2025)

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Transit & Parking.

Mosby's Popcorn is located along Ionia Avenue in downtown Grand Rapids and is easily reached by several city bus routes. Street parking is available directly along Ionia Avenue, with metered spaces monitored by posted signage. The sidewalk at these spaces includes a small curb step, so those using mobility devices may prefer to access the building using nearby crosswalks for smoother entry.

Entrances.

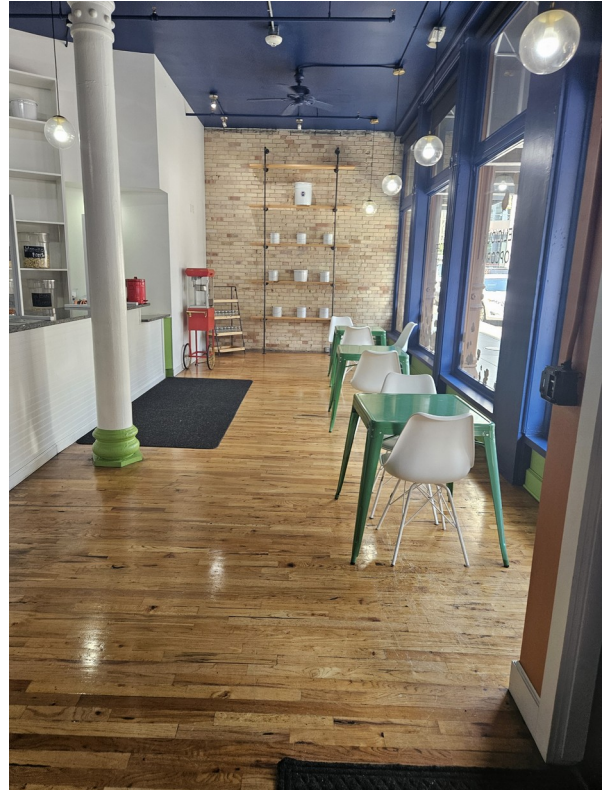
The main entrance to Mosby's faces Ionia Avenue. It includes a tall single step leading to a set of double manual doors, which are heavy and do not offer automated assistance. An alternative entrance exists but involves a more complex route. To use it, visitors would first enter the vestibule of the neighboring building through a manual door, then navigate through a shared indoor lobby that includes couch seating and a low coffee table. Another single manual door in this area leads to a hallway where a ramp is available. In this same space, restrooms are located and visible, along with stairs and a final door that has a push bar and window cut-outs. This door opens to the back entrance of Mosby's Popcorn and offers level access into the business.

Inside / Getting Around.

Once inside, visitors enter directly onto a single-level floor with no internal elevation changes. The space

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is compact but navigable. The main ordering counter does not include a lowered section for accessibility. Three dining tables with chairs are available and positioned near the front windows. Lighting is provided by bright white overhead fixtures combined with natural daylight that enters through large street-facing windows. The scent of sweet and buttery popcorn is strong and consistent throughout the space, which may be a sensory concern for some individuals.



Restrooms.

Restrooms are technically shared with the adjoining interior lobby space and are accessed through either the back hallway door (mentioned in the alternate entrance route) or from the ramp room visible from Mosby's rear entry. Two restrooms are available, one designated for men and the other for women, each designed for multiple users. The men's room has a wider interior space with an adequate turning radius, while the women's room is noticeably narrower and lacks ample maneuvering room. Both restrooms feature automated sinks and standard stall layouts, but neither is formally labeled as accessible. The route to the restrooms involves multiple transitions between buildings and may present navigation challenges.



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Additional Notes.

Visitors who require step-free access should plan to use the secondary route described above and may benefit from calling ahead or bringing a companion to assist with doors. Although the building interior is on a single level and generally open, the combination of multiple manual doors and shared building infrastructure makes accessibility less straightforward.
