Parking and Exterior Lighting.

The Amway Grand Plaza Parking Garage is a gated parking ramp across Pearl Street NW, south of the venue. There is a driveway entrance and exit along Pearl Street NW, and a driveway entrance and exit along Campau Avenue. There are designated accessible parking spaces with adjacent access aisles present, indicated with signage. Van-accessible parking is available.

Main Entrance and Accessibility.

Woodrows Duckpin Bowling is bowling alley and bar on the first floor of the larger Amway Grand Plaza, Curio Collection by Hilton, in the center of the Downtown Grand Rapids area.

The entrance is along Lyon Street NW. There is no powered door present, but the door requires very little force to open. The entrance opens directly into the barroom. The entrance is flush with the sidewalks in front of the venue. The sidewalks are flush with the street.

Interior Layout and Navigation.

The venue is a large bar space on the first floor of the larger Amway Grand Plaza, Curio Collection by Hilton hotel. The venue is separated into 3 levels. Stairs and a shallowly sloped ramp system provide access between the ground level and middle tier. Stairs provide access between the middle and top tiers. An accessible route between the middle and top tiers of the barroom may be found in the sloped hotel corridor outside the venue. There is an entrance to the top tier of the barroom on the hotel side.

The barroom has low table with chair, sofa and chair, and high table with stool seating options available. There is also high bar with stool seating available. There is no lowered section of counter present.



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Lighting and Atmosphere.

The barroom is well-lit, primarily by natural light from large windows.

The venue has high ceilings.

The venue plays moderate volume background music.

The venue has tile and finished concrete floors throughout.

Restrooms.

There are men's and women's single-user restrooms available on the top tier of the barroom. The interiors are spacious. The toilets have grab bars. The toilets are automatically operated. The sinks are manually operated.

There are children's changing tables present.
