Parking.

On-street metered parking is available along Monroe Center, with streetlamp lighting providing adequate illumination in the evening.

Entrances.

The salon has one main entrance featuring a flush ramp leading to manual double doors. During the visit, only one door was open, and it was heavy, potentially posing a challenge for some visitors. Upon entry, guests encounter a receptionist desk without a lowered section, which may limit accessibility.

Inside / Getting Around.



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The salon is arranged on a single-level floor plan with distinct sections, including a waiting area, styling stations and a dedicated lash suite. The waiting area includes a mix of seating options, such as cushioned couches and backless bar stools positioned near the windows. Aisles are generally wide and accessible, allowing easy navigation throughout the space.

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Sensory Experience.

Lighting is bright and natural, thanks to large windows and glass doors. Overhead fixtures emit both white and yellow tones, contributing to a warm atmosphere. The environment was quiet during the visit, with low background music. Noise levels may increase during busy periods due to hair dryers and conversations. The primary scent present was from salon products.



Restrooms.

One single-user, multi-gender restroom is available for customers. It features a wide manual door, a good turning radius inside, a manual toilet, and a sink with adequate knee clearance.

Additional Amenities.

Outdoor seating in the form of city benches is available nearby for customer use.
