Parking.

On-street metered parking is available along Monroe Center. The area is well-lit with streetlamps, providing adequate visibility during evening hours.



Entrance.

The main entrance is located directly off Monroe Center and consists of a single manual push/pull door. A slight bump or step is present at the threshold, which may pose a minor barrier for some visitors.

Interior Layout and Circulation.

The shop is located on a single level. Inside, shelving units stocked with books and merchandise are arranged into aisles, along with several display tables. Aisles are generally wide enough for navigation, though the space may become congested during busy periods. The service counter does not include a lowered section. Potential access barriers include open drawers at the base of shelving units, which may obstruct pathways.

Sensory Environment.

Lighting is bright, with a combination of overhead fluorescent white lights and natural light from front-facing windows and the

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entrance. Walls are painted in vibrant, playful colors. The atmosphere is typically quiet but can become loud during peak times.
