

## Downtown Accessibility Navigator

### The Monarchs Club (last updated July 2024)

646 Stocking Avenue NW, Grand Rapids, Michigan 49504



#### Outside.

The Monarchs Club is a bar and restaurant in the northern part of the Grand Rapids Area.

The Monarchs Club Parking Lot is a surface lot adjacent to the venue. There is a driveway entrance and exit along 4<sup>th</sup> Street NW. There are designated accessible parking spaces with adjacent access aisles present. There is a van-accessible parking space with adjacent access aisle. The spaces are not indicated with signage.

There is metered on-street parking available along the east side of the Stocking Avenue NW, on the west side of the venue. There are two designated accessible on-street parking spaces near the Main Entrance. There are no access aisles present, and no bike lanes present to provide a buffer for street traffic.

#### Entrances.

The Main Entrance is at the 4<sup>th</sup> Street NW and Stocking Avenue NW intersection. There is a set of steps.



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The Parking Lot entrance is along 4<sup>th</sup> Street NW. There is a ramp along the sidewalk that leads up to the entrance. There is no power door present. The Parking Lot entrance leads directly to the rear dining room.

### **Inside.**

The Front Bar Room is a long dining area, with high ceilings and tall windows overlooking Stocking Avenue NW and 4<sup>th</sup> Street NW. There is table with chair, and bar with stool seating available. There is no lowered section of bar counter present.

There is an outdoor dining patio in the back. There is chair with table seating available. The routes between the tables are wide.

The Parking Lot Entrance leads directly to the Rear Dining Hall. There is a step present between the Rear Dining Hall and the Front Bar Room. At the time of review, The Monarch Club has stated that, should staff be available, they may assist guests in moving up and down the step. During busy hours, staff may not be available to help.

The Bar Room and Dining Hall may experience elevated noise levels during busy hours.

There are Men's and Women's multi-user style restrooms with designated accessible stalls available. The sinks are located in a cabinet, and do not have roll-under-capacity. The paper towel dispensers may be mounted high on the wall.
