



Living Dependent on the Spirit – Pastor Steve Huffman

1. At the beginning of his message Pastor Steve talked about things he is dependent on to get him through the day. What are some things people rely on every day of their life?
2. Read 1 Corinthians 2:10-11.

Pastor Steve's first point is that living dependent on the Spirit gives us ongoing access to the perfect advocate. What is your definition of an advocate? Why do you think it is essential to have an advocate that has our best interests in mind?

3. Pastor Steve's second point was that the Holy Spirit provides a reliable teacher for all situations. Have you had a faithful teacher in your life? If so, how have they impacted you?
4. Read and discuss Galatians 5:22-23.

Relying on the Spirit yields excellent fruit. What fruits of the Spirit do you see in your life? What fruits do you wish you displayed more?

5. What did Pastor Steve mean when he said, "If we wait for the world to inform us fully, we might miss the God opportunity in front of us." Share an example from your own life when you either missed the God opportunity or saw/responded to one.
6. Pastor Steve said that living dependent on the Spirit takes relationship, constant connection, and responding to the nudge. Which step resonated with you most and why?
7. When it comes to a relationship, constant connection, and responding to the nudge, which is most difficult for you, what are you going to do this week to pursue that step?
