1. Have you ever been on the receiving end of a heroic act? What was that experience like?
2. Who would you be willing to die for? Why?
3. Read Romans 5:6-8.
In books and movies, the hero's typically rescue the innocent victims. Who did Jesus come to rescue? What does this tell you about God's heart?
4. Pastor Mark taught that God's heart to intervene is extreme. Do you believe this to be true? Have you seen examples in your own life of God intervening?
5. Jesus isn't just a one-time sacrifice, He's a lifetime savior. What does this mean? How does this effect the way you live your life?
6. Is it easy or difficult for you to believe that the cross paid for all your sins? Explain why.
7. Pastor Mark reminded us not to write anyone off this Easter. Is there someone you have written off as too hopeless to be saved? How has Pastor Mark's message effected your mindset about that?
8. Pastor Mark reminded us to thank God for all He's done. What are some things you are thankful for? What can you do this week to intentionally show thankfulness to God for those things?
9. During this season of staying home, what can you do to rely on God as your hero? How can you stay focused on Him during this time?
