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## Humility: Finding Value in Others – Pastor Steve Huffman March 30 & 31, 2019

1. Pastor Steve opened his talk about hating group projects. He said there are 3 folks in a group project; the dreamer, the person that disappears, and the person that did all the work. What has been your group project experiences?
2. Are there areas of your life do you feel like you're better alone than together? Why?
3. Read Matthew 20:28. Jesus had every right to elevate himself, yet he came to serve. Why do you think Jesus came as a humble servant rather than a grand king?
4. Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-10  
The Scripture speaks of the value of having someone to help you up. Can you recall a time someone has helped you up? What did that look like?
5. John 4 gives an account of Jesus and a Samaritan woman at the well; Matthew 19:14 gives an account of Jesus and the importance He placed on children. Jesus made a point in showing the value of all people, even those who were considered lowlier in the eyes of the world. In your daily activities, what are some practical ways you can communicate value to others?
6. Sometimes it is hard to be humble, other times it is hard to be confident in our giftings. Which area do you struggle the most in? How do you think being sober minded could help with that struggle?
7. Jesus modeled serving others well by not being too important to serve. How are you serving others well? Do you need to change the way you serve or start serving? Be specific.
8. Romans 12:5-6 talks about the different giftings we have and how they contribute to the body of Christ. What have you done to encourage others' gifts and talents? Have you ever discouraged someone in these areas? How can you make that right?
9. Jesus saw value in the disciples and invited them to join him. Can you identify someone in your life who could benefit from calling out of their gifts? Who have you identified and what gifts will you call out?

BONUS QUESTION: Who will you invite to church this Good Friday and/or Easter?
