Redemption After Repentance: David Responds to His Sin Pastor Steve Huffman July 28 & 29, 2019

1. Pastor Steve showed a picture of his kitchen sink full of dishes. Is there one specific place in your house that always seems to be messy?
2. What part of Pastor Steve's message resonated most with you? Was there one point that really stuck out?
3. Read Acts 3:19
When was the last time you repented of a sin? Did you experience some sort of spiritual refreshment afterwards? What did that look like for you?
4. Do you have a tendency to take full responsibility for a mess, or do you tend to shift or explain away the blame? Why do you think you respond this particular way? Why is it important to take responsibility for your own sins?
5. Read James 5:16
This verse promises that if we confess our sins to others, we will be healed. Why is confessing our sins to each other important? Have you ever done this? If so, has it helped keep you accountable?
6. Are there any messes in your life now that you need to repent for? What is the first step you should take to turn your path in the other direction?
7. Read Psalm 32:3-5.
Is there a heaviness of guilt you are still carrying around from something you've done? What needs to occur so you can let it go?
8. After confession, why is it important to look beyond the wreck? What can you do to shift your perspective to focus on the story God is still writing for your life? How can you step into the calling God has given you?
