Connected For a Cause: Easy Ways to Offer Christ to Our Friends – Pastor Mark Pope

1. Pastor Mark mentioned a few great moments in his life. What was one of the greatest moments in your life?
2. Paul shared that his words were neither wise or persuasive. Have you ever heard a testimony that perhaps wasn't polished or with the best delivery but impacted your life anyhow? Does that encourage you to be bold in sharing Christ?
3. Read 1 Corinthians 2:1-5. How did Paul approach the Corinthians? What were his methods? Why do you think he did it that way? Why did Paul resolve to know only one thing?
4. Has there ever been a time in your life you feel God had opened a door for you to share the gospel and you didn't do it? What held you back? What can you do today to prepare yourself for the next opportunity to share the truth of Jesus with someone?
5. Did you think of someone when Mark asked us to pray for someone we know who does not know Jesus? Has the message this weekend encouraged you to present Jesus to them? What would you risk by presenting the gospel to them? What could be gained?
6. Pastor Mark said, Paul did the best he could and God added His power. Where have you seen God add his power? Why do you think God added power in those moments (and not others?)
7. The music video by Casting Crowns showed a story of a young lady constantly being overlooked by those around her. It only took one interaction to change the direction of her life. Does it motivate you to share the Gospel or the love of Jesus Christ, to know that one interaction could change someone's life? Can you think of someone who did that for you?
8. Pastor Mark talked about sometimes it is difficult for people to get off the soap box tangent topic that they feel strongly about. Is your soap box tangent topic keeping you from sharing the gospel?
9. What is one thing you can do today to share the gospel of Jesus Christ?
