1. When have you had a "This has to stop" moment? A moment when you saw something evil that needed to change. Maybe you spoke up or did not but express the effect it had on you.
2. Read Exodus 14:15-16, 21, 26-27. What was Moses's part in the story? Was there more to it than just raising his hand? Do you think it was any harder for Moses to raise his hand in verses 26-27 than in verse 21?
3. Why do you think God wants to partner with us when He could handle it alone? What was the effect of this partnership in the text? How did it affect the Egyptians? How did it affect the Israelites? What would it look like to get back into the fight?
4. Share a time when you encountered the emotional rub (being uncomfortable) of trying to end something you felt was wrong.
5. What is your current tolerance for evil? What is one way that you can be more ready to stand up to evil?
6. Where in your life do you need to take a stand against evil? What changes do you need to make to do this?
