1. In what area of life do you tend to be most competitive, what brings that side out of you?

3. Look at Proverbs 13:20. How have the people you surround yourself with influenced the direction, strength, or spiritual health of your life?

5. Moses became tired, and Aaron and Hur stepped in to hold up his hands; what does this teach us about recognizing when we need help and being willing to help others? (Exodus 17:12, Eccl. 4:9-10)
6. Think about one area you want to experience greater victory right now; what is one adjustment you need to make in your connection to Jesus, and one person or community you need to lean into this week?
