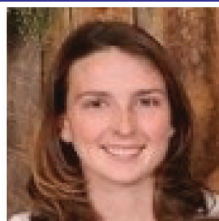

Steak Fajita Burrito Bowl

Makes: 4 bowls

- 3 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 1 pound skirt steak
- 1 red pepper, sliced
- 1 yellow pepper, sliced
- 1 package instant rice
- 1 tablespoon fresh lime juice
- 1/2 packet Ortega Original Taco Seasoning
- 1 Ortega Bakeable Tortilla Bowl Kit
- 3 cups green leaf lettuce, sliced
- 2 avocados, diced
- 1 cup corn kernels
- 1/2 cup cotija cheese

Mexican menu ideas for simple family dinners

FAMILY FEATURES

When the school year is back in full swing, families often find themselves battling the mealtime crunch.
