(Bookmark) on the back of the remote control does not work. You cannot enter characters by using the back (keyboard) of the remote control. If you connect the Smart Stick to the TV equipped with DISCOVER, the TV button can turn on DISCOVER mode. You cannot use remote control buttons other than vol +/- (VOLUME), (MUTING), and INPUT while using social media view or Skype. NOTE: For BRAVIA TVs sold before 2012, the remote control sensor is located on the infrared symbol at the bottom of the BRAVIA TV.
