Are You Ready to Lead Someone to Christ?

Philip the evangelist in Acts 8 is an excellent example of a Christian who was ready to evangelize. Really being ready to lead someone to Christ isn't something that occurs by accident! Here are a few helpful lessons we can learn.

He Was Sensitive to the Will of God. An angel of the Lord told him to "rise and go," and off Philip went (Acts 8:26-27). Think about it – if given the opportunity, Philip understood he was to evangelize! Although God may not speak so directly to us, being sensitive to possible opportunities for evangelism should be a high priority for us too.

He Was Available. Philip was not too busy and offered no excuses. He simply "rose and went" (Acts 8:26-27).

He Was Willing to Undergo the "Inconvenience" of Extra Effort. Philip had to "go over," "join" and run" to get to the Ethiopian nobleman (8:29-31). Those who have "good and honest hearts" in evangelizing are willing to do the same thing today.

He Was Natural, Conversational and Tactful. Read Acts 8:30-34. A conversation about Jesus naturally grew out of the circumstances with the nobleman. Too many attempts at evangelism today are anything but natural, conversational and tactful.

He Was Biblical (See Acts 8:30-35). "He told him the good news about Jesus" (Acts 8:35). The emphasis was upon what Scripture taught regarding the person and work of Jesus. Wise evangelists today beautifully explain from Scripture who Jesus is and what He wants men to do.

He Was Persuasive. That's what Acts 8:36-40. He was persuasive because of his subject and approach (Eph. 4:15; 2 Tim. 4:2). He was persuasive because of the things already mentioned! Even if the nobleman had NOT come to Jesus, it would not have been due to something lacking in Philip.

He Was Conclusive. Philip helped bring the nobleman to the point where he knew he needed to come to Christ. We need to get people to the same point today.
