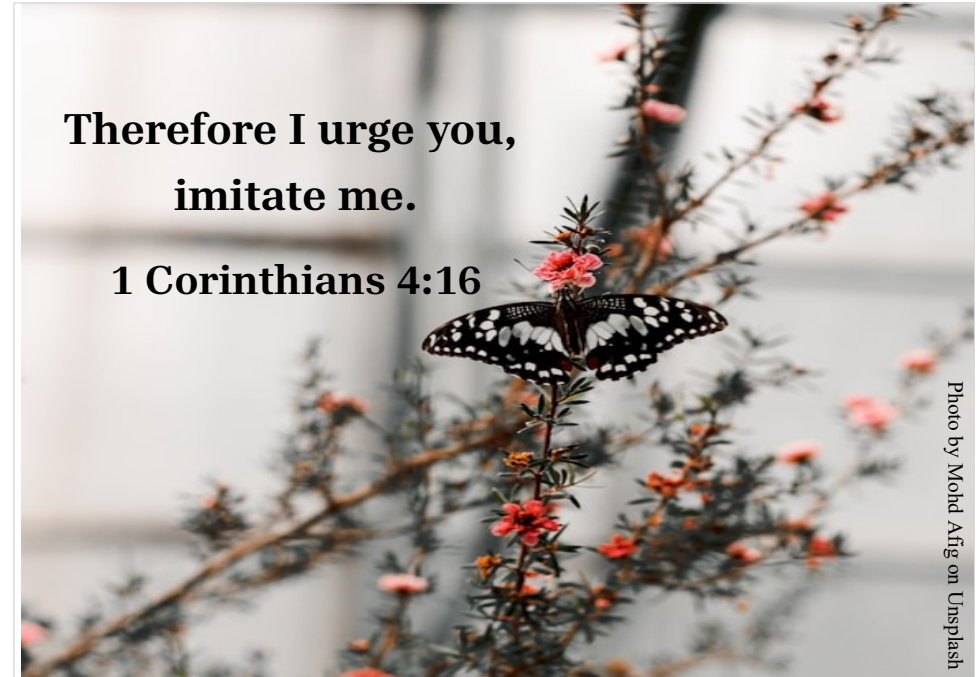

**I Corinthians 11:1** – Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ.

**Ephesians 5:1-2** – Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

**Philippians 2:5** – Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus.
