

**The Minnesota Wild “2026 Playoff Ticket Scratch-to-Win”
Official Rules**

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SWEEPSTAKES.

This Sweepstakes, as defined herein, is powered by Wit Labs, Inc. (“Wit”) on behalf of the Minnesota Wild Hockey Club, LP (“Wild”), and is accessible via the Wit website at witcontests.com (the “Platform”). For the avoidance of doubt, Wit administers and provides the Platform for the Sweepstakes, but is not the sponsor for the Sweepstakes. To participate in the Sweepstakes, entrants must agree to the Wit Terms of Use located at <https://witcontests.com/terms>.

1. ELIGIBILITY. The Minnesota Wild “2026 Playoff Ticket Scratch-to-Win” Sweepstakes (the “Sweepstakes”) is only open to entrants who, as of the entry date, are permanent legal residents of the States of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota, and who are at least eighteen (18) years old. The Sweepstakes is void outside of the States of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota and where prohibited or restricted by law. Employees, officers and directors of the Wild, and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, divisions, advertising and promotion agencies, and the immediate families (defined as parents, spouses, children, siblings, grandparents, and their respective spouses) or members of the same household (whether related or not) of each such employee, officer and director, are not eligible to enter. The Sweepstakes, and any website pages and advertisements relating thereto, is intended for viewing only within the eligible Sweepstakes territory, and entrants must be present in the eligible Sweepstakes territory at the time they enter.

2. SWEEPSTAKES ADMINISTRATION. Wit, on behalf of the Wild, performs the collection, submission or processing of entries, as well as the overall administration of the Sweepstakes. 3. SWEEPSTAKES PERIOD. The Sweepstakes period begins at **4:00 p.m.** Central Standard Time (“CST”) on **April 21, 2026**, and ends at **11:59 p.m.** CST on **April 29, 2026** (the “Sweepstakes Period”). The Sweepstakes Period is divided into three (3) entry periods (“Entry Period”), as defined in the chart below. Wit’s database clock is the official timekeeping device for the Sweepstakes.

4. HOW TO ENTER AND COMPLIANCE WITH OFFICIAL RULES

a. HOW TO ENTER: There are two (2) way(s) to enter this Sweepstakes.

(1) **TO ENTER ONLINE:** During the Sweepstakes Period, go to <https://web.witcontests.com/wild/giveaway/scratchnwin/minnesota-wild-2026-playoff-ti-260420> and follow the instructions for entry. All entries must be received by Wit

during the Sweepstakes Period. Potential winners may be required to show proof of being the authorized entrant.

- (2) **TO ENTER VIA MAIL: LIMIT:** One (1) mail in entry per person and address (physical or email) in the Sweepstakes. All entries must be received by Wit during the Sweepstakes Period and become the exclusive property of the Sweepstakes Entities. None will be acknowledged or returned. All entrants and entries subject to verification prior to the awarding of a prize, as are the eligibility, age and other claims of/information provided by a potential prize winner. All entries may be sent via a self-addressed postage-stamped envelope to “2026 Playoff Ticket Scratch-to-Win” Minnesota Wild, 317 Washington St., St. Paul, Minnesota 55102.

b. **COMPLIANCE WITH OFFICIAL RULES:** Failure to submit all required information in the manner required in these Official Rules may result in disqualification. Entries will not be acknowledged or returned. Proof of submission will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by Wild or Wit. Any submission that does not comply with any aspect of these Official Rules may be rejected by the Wild or Wit and the entrant disqualified.

5. AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES AND DECISIONS. By participating in the Sweepstakes, each entrant fully and unconditionally agrees to be bound by and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of the Wild and Wit (including, without limitation, decisions regarding eligibility of entries, the selection of entrants and the winners, and the awarding of prizes), which are final and binding in all respects.

6. SWEEPSTAKES DRAWING. During the Sweepstakes Period, eleven (11) winners will be selected in a random drawing from all eligible entries received by the Wit. Entry Period 1 Drawing: One (1) winner will be selected in a random drawing to be held on or about April 22, 2026, from among all eligible entries received by the Wit during Entry Period 1. Non-winning Entries from Entry Period 1 will carry forward to the Grand Prize, as defined herein, drawing.

Entry Period 2 Drawing: One (1) winner will be selected in a random drawing to be held on or about April 25, 2026, from among all eligible entries received by the Wit during Entry Period 2. Non-winning Entries from Entry Period 2 will carry forward to the Grand Prize, as defined herein, drawing.

Entry Period 3 Drawing: One (1) winner will be selected in a random drawing to be held on or about April 30, 2026, from among all eligible entries received by the Wit during Entry Period 3. Non-winning Entries from Entry Period 3 will carry forward to the Grand Prize, as defined herein, drawing.

7. SELECTION OF WINNING ENTRY; ODDS; NOTIFICATION. All prizes will be awarded and potential winners will be notified by email or phone call and will be required to respond to the notification within twenty-four (24) hours (time permitting) indicating whether he/she can accept the prize. If potential winner does not respond to the notification within the twenty-four (24) hour time period (time permitting), prize will be forfeited and an alternate potential winner will be randomly selected (time permitting). Any alternate potential winner selected will also be required to respond to the notification within the time frame stated above. Odds of being selected depend on the number of eligible entries received by Wit during the Sweepstakes. Entry Period 2 Prize: On or about April 25, 2026, one (1) prize will be awarded to one (1) winner during this Entry Period 2 and winner shall receive two (2) tickets to the Minnesota Wild 2026 Playoffs Round 1 Home Game 2 hockey game scheduled for April 25, 2026, at Grand Casino Arena located at 199 W Kellogg Boulevard, Saint Paul, Minnesota, 55102. The ARV of the prize is one hundred fifty-two and 23/100 U.S. dollars (\$152.23).

Entry Period 3 Prize: On or about April 30, 2026, one (1) prize will be awarded to one (1) winner during this Entry Period 3 and winner shall receive two (2) tickets to the Minnesota Wild 2026 Playoffs Round 1 Home Game 3 hockey game scheduled for April 30, 2026, at Grand Casino Arena located at 199 W Kellogg Boulevard, Saint Paul, Minnesota, 55102. The ARV of the prize is one hundred fifty-two and 23/100 U.S. dollars (\$152.23).

Sweepstakes Period Prize(s): one (1) prize will be awarded to eleven (11) winners during the Sweepstakes Period and awarded as follows:

- a. One (1) winner shall receive one (1) autographed Wild 25th Anniversary book. The ARV of the prize is one hundred fifty and 00/100 U.S. dollars (\$150.00).
