

## Highlights from the Press – Weingut Wittman 2020


### Wittmann Morstein Riesling GG 2020

If you have enough patience, this will turn into one of the greatest dry Rieslings of the vintage. A tight rose bud in the nose and on the front palate, but then the wine expands in an almost supernatural fashion as it flows over the palate. Staggering minerality at the totally focused finish. From organically grown grapes. Drinkable now, but best from 2024. *August 2021*

### Wittmann Brunnenhäuschen Riesling GG 2020





A radical and enormously structured dry Riesling that's still very youthful and slightly yeasty, but already shows pronounced white-thorn and Amalfi-lemon notes. Seriously concentrated, the power very present, but not a jot loud. Stunning finish! From organically grown grapes. Drinkable now, but best from 2023. *August 2021*

[91+] *Mosel Fine Wines*

Offers a quite herbal and still restrained nose of rosemary, thyme, black berry, licorice, and prune. The wine starts off on the smoother and juicier side on the palate, yet quickly reveals quite some tartness complexity, the wine is very primary and rough at this stage and will need more than a couple of years to integrate all its elements and shine. It is not without upside, especially if it manages to slightly gain finesse over time. 2025-2030+. *September 2021*

### Wittmann Aulerde Riesling GG 2020





Stunning nose of pineapple and mirabelle that's still so youthful. Concentrated and energetic with great mineral vitality and salty intensity. From vines planted in 1949 and 1951. From organically grown grapes. Drinkable now, but best from 2023. *August 2021*

[90] *Mosel Fine Wines*

Offers an attractive creamy nose of almond, coconut, earthy spices, rosemary, and pineapple. The wine is nicely structured on the palate, where zesty and herbal elements are wrapped into dry extract and a touch of power. The finish is very long, herbal, and zesty, with tartness and tannins in need of integration. This broad and aromatic expression of dry Riesling will please lovers of more ostentation expressions of the genre. 2024-2028. *September 2021*


### Wittmann Westhofener Riesling "Aus Ersten Lagen" 2020

Only just opening up on the peach and fresh-herb nose and the front palate is also refined and delicate. Then the chalky minerality builds and builds like the Eifel tower to a narrow point that's precisely delineated. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold. *August 2021*


### Wittmann Kirchspiel Riesling GG 2020

Very ripe and very fine peach and citrus fruit, but the complex herb and spice notes are even more intense. Tightly wound and very pristine for this rather warm region, the spice returning at the super-long finish. From organically grown grapes. Drinkable now, but best from 2023. *August 2021*

### Wittmann Estate Riesling Trocken 2020



Wonderful peach, melon, and floral nose. Concentrated, racy and filigree with intense, chalky minerality at the long, polished, and playful finish. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold. *August 2021*



### Wittmann Weisser Burgunder 2020





Deep and subtle nose with a complex interplay of white fruit, herbs and yeasty notes from long sur-lie maturation. Excellent combination of creaminess and raciness on the medium-to full-bodied palate. Long, dry finish. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

### Wittmann Grauer Burgunder Trocken 2020





Lovely ripe-melon, caramelized-pear and melted-butter character, full body, but with nice mineral freshness that makes it feel lighter than it really is. Bold and well-balanced finish. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

### Wittmann 100 Hills Pinot Blanc 2020

Full of Asian-pear, white-peach and fresh-herb aromas, excellent harmony of fruit, medium body and animating freshness. From organically grown grapes. Drink now.

### Wittmann 100 Hills Riesling 2020

Plenty of nutty apple and quince aromas and a juicy, generous body with very lively acidity that gives this considerable appeal. From organically grown grapes. Drink now.

### Wittmann Westhofener Morstein La Borne Riesling Trocken Alte Reben 2020

Explosive mirabelle, preserved-lemon, dill and sea-salt character that bowls you over and charges off in the direction of infinity. Gigantic finish that's so precisely delineated. From organically grown grapes. Drinkable now, but best from 2024. *August 2021*

### **[18.5] *Jancis Robinson***

La Borne is a small special parcel of old vines in the Morstein vineyard, something like the holy grail of Philipp Wittmann's dry Riesling kingdom. The vines have been cultivated by biodynamic methods for many years now, and there can be no doubt that this contributes to the expression of pure minerality and clean fruit. The palate combines the ripe and yet crisp flavor of stone fruit with a subtle herbal freshness and a touch of solid rock on the finish. Drink 2022-2035. *August 2021*
