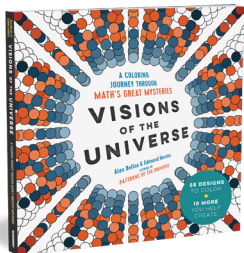


FIELD OF CUBES

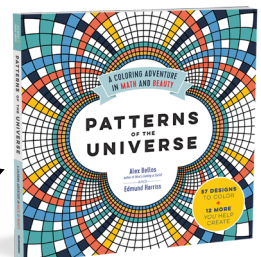

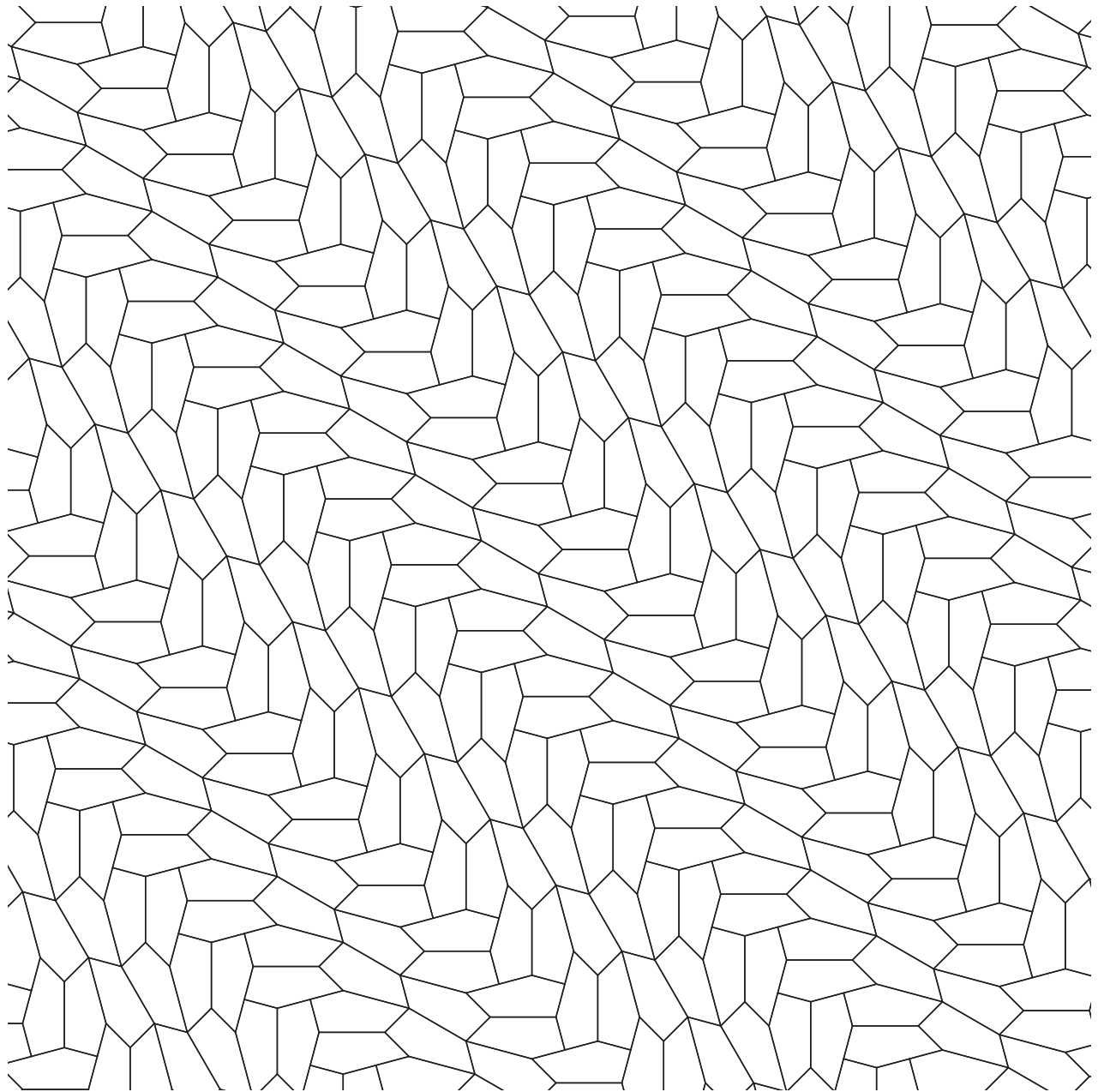

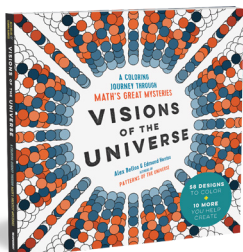

THE FIFTEENTH PENTAGON

In 2015 Casey Mann, Jennifer McCloud, and David Von Derau of the University of Washington Bothell made international news when they discovered a new pentagon (above) that can tile the plane. It is the first type of pentagon to be discovered in more than three decades, and only the fifteenth since the German mathematician Karl Reinhardt began the classification of pentagon types in 1918.
