Assist the locals with their much needed construction support by getting your hands dirty and give something back the community! This program is designed to support the local people by helping in local community construction and renovation projects. These construction and renovation projects mainly take place at local people's houses and community facilities such as; local medical centres, temples and schools.



Program Description

You will partake in the Community Construction program to improve the living standards of local people in need. In this area of Thailand, there are still many families living under very poor housing circumstances and without basic sanitation facilities. Within this program the local village head has selected local families who are in need of construction support regarding their current living standards.

It is at these houses where the team will undertake construction and renovation efforts such as:

- Creating proper sanitation facilities
- Repairing roofing
- Painting
- Other construction and renovation needed to make these houses a safe place to live

The Community Construction project can also take place at local facilities such as:

- Temples
- Hospitals
- Schools
- Other community areas that require our community construction team's assistance

After breakfast, you will head off to the construction project; this will mainly be at local people's houses and local community facilities. There you will be briefed on your tasks by our coordinator about the day's project. Expect to do construction and renovation work at the project location for 4-5 hours per day with a lunch break in between. Lunch can be at our accommodation or near the project site.
