Encourage education in the class by creating innovative learning experiences while assisting the teachers in the day to day tasks and responsibilities.

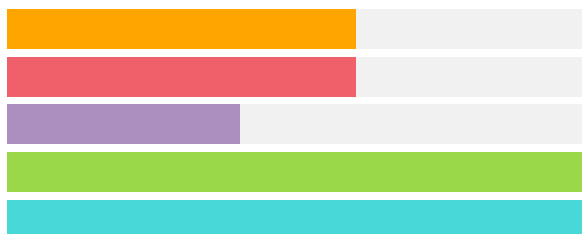
