

## **GÖKHAN KABAÇAM**

Dr. Kabaçam graduated from Hacettepe University School of Medicine (English) in 2001, and completed his residency in Internal Medicine and fellowship in Gastroenterology, at Ankara University School of Medicine.

He has published around 32 studies in SCI+E with a “h index” of 11. Among his recognitions, he was awarded the EASL Young investigator award 4 times with his studies on Delta hepatitis. He has 2 years of experience as Assistant Editor for the Turkish Journal of Gastroenterology (SCIE). Since 2015 he is Assoc. Prof of Gastroenterology at Ankara Guven Hospital (Attendant of Gastroenterology and Medical Coordinator of Liver Transplantation). This is one of the busiest transplant programs in the Country performing 40+ live donor liver transplants per year, and registered with ELTR. Besides liver transplant clinics, he is actively involved in endoscopic procedures, ERCP’s. In 2016, he received a bursary from the Turkish Society of Gastroenterology, to attend Johns Hopkins School of Medicine, Comprehensive Liver Transplantation Unit, Baltimore, USA as a visiting professor, under the supervision of Dr. Gurakar. He has been a member of EASL, and TASL for long time, and recently elected as the secretary of Liver Transplantation Special Interest Group of TASL.

His future plan is to increase the level of collaboration and find ways to ease sharing of knowledge and experience to enhance quality of the care of transplant patients.
