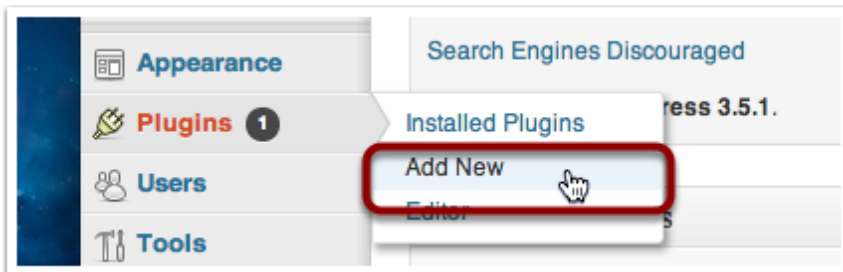


Share Per View User Guide

Installing A Plugin

To install a plugin, go to Plugins >> Add New



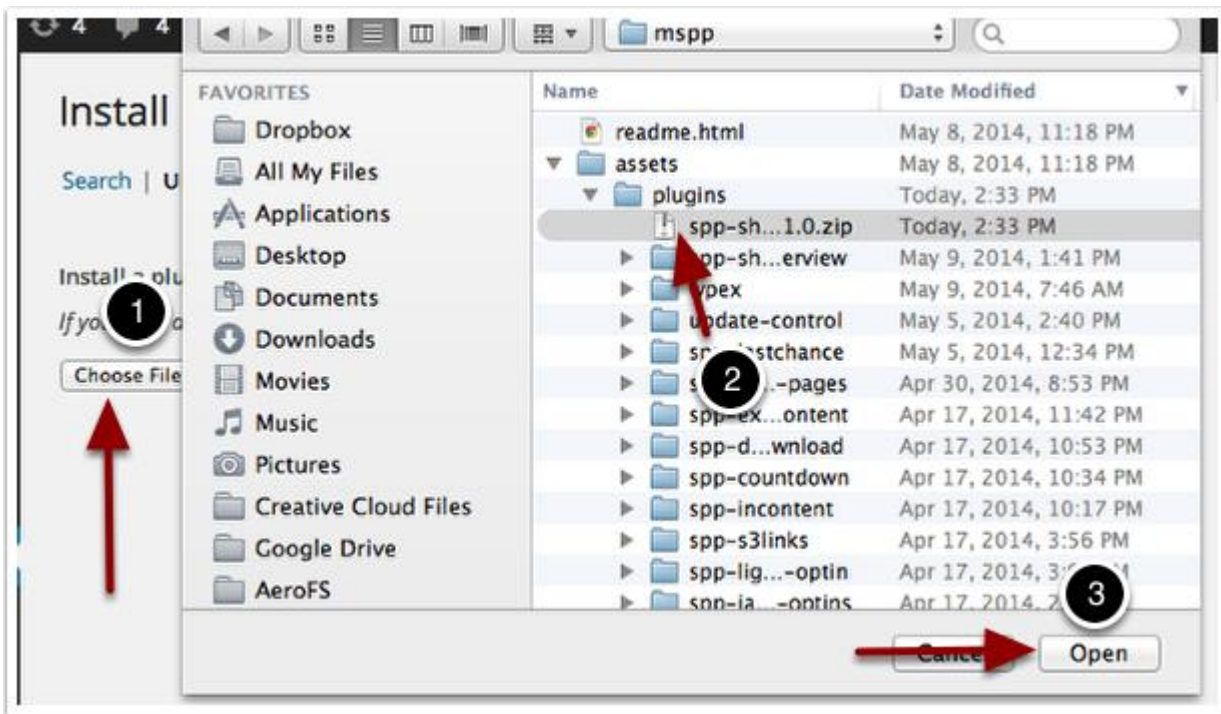
Upload plugin

Click Upload



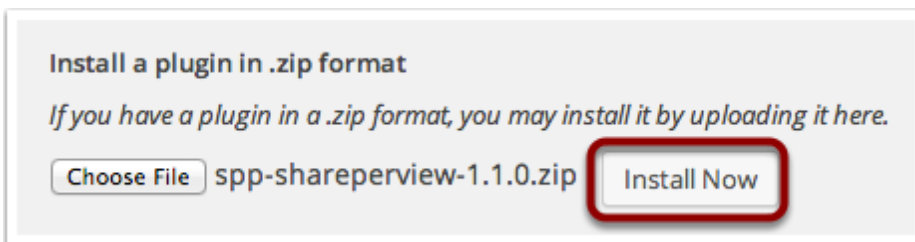
Choose Upload File

1. Click Choose File
2. Locate the zipped file of the plugin you'd like to install
3. Click Open

Activate The Plugin

After successfully unpacking and installing the plugin, click *Activate Plugin*.

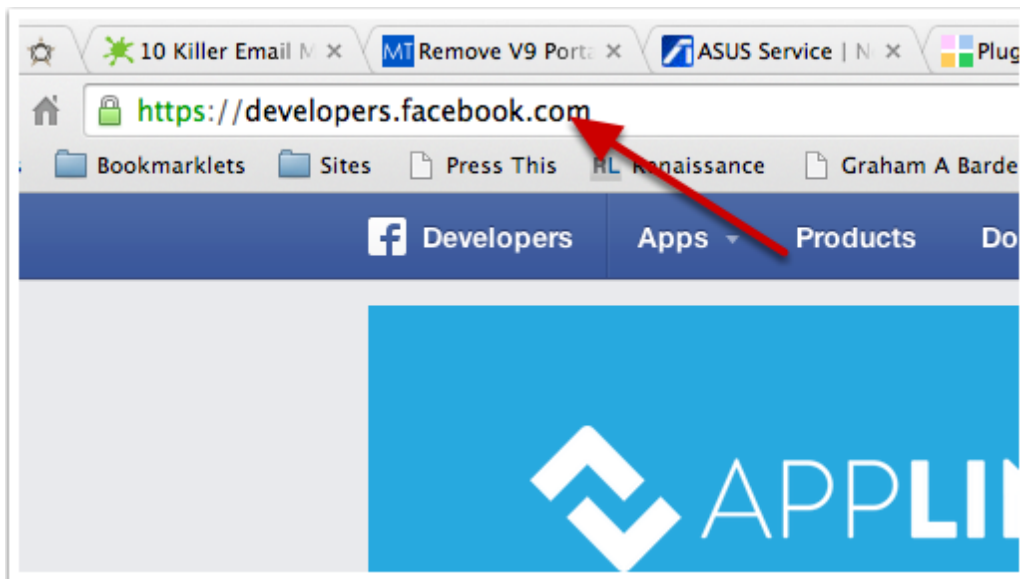

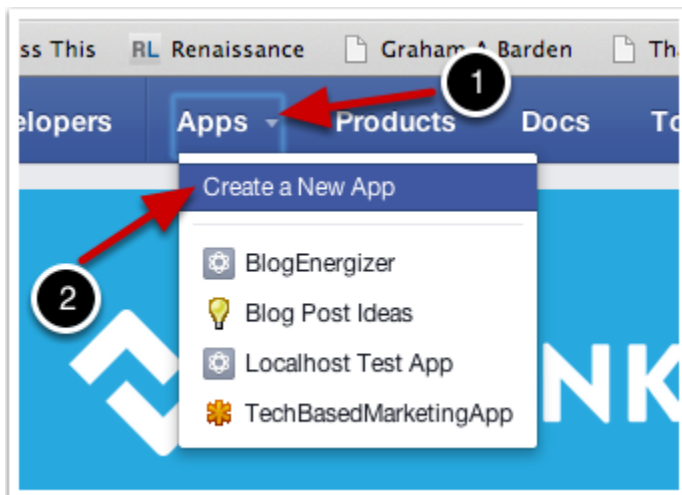
Create A New Facebook App

In order to use the plugin, a Facebook App ID is required. To obtain an app ID, you must create a Facebook App. While logged into your account, go to Facebook Developers Website at <https://developers.facebook.com>



Create A New App

Click the Apps dropdown in the menu. Click Create a New App



Enter App Details

1. In the Display Name, enter a name for your app. It can be anything such as MyWebsite Apps.
2. Next, choose a category from the drop down.
3. Click Create App

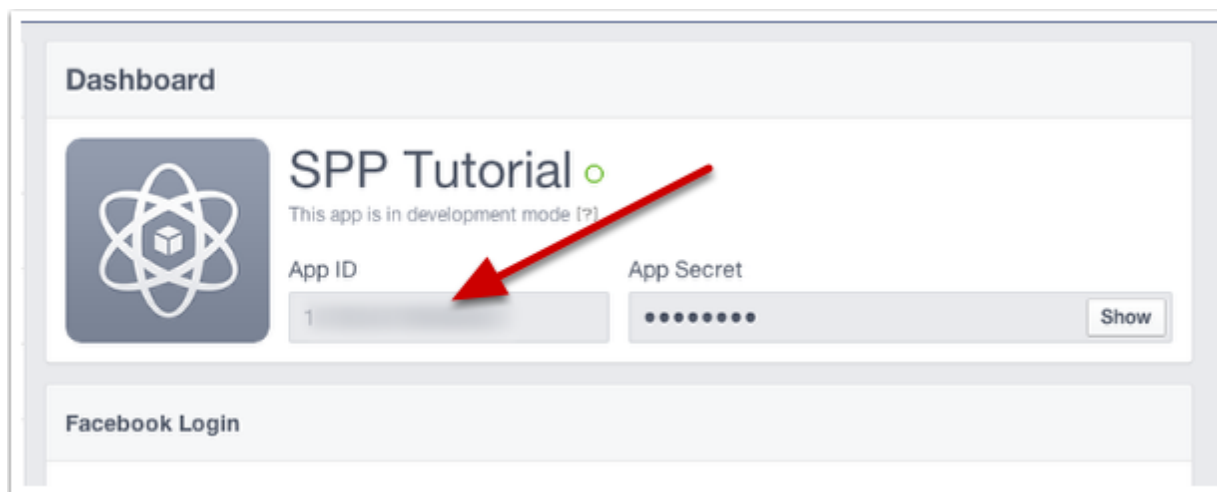
Enter Security Code

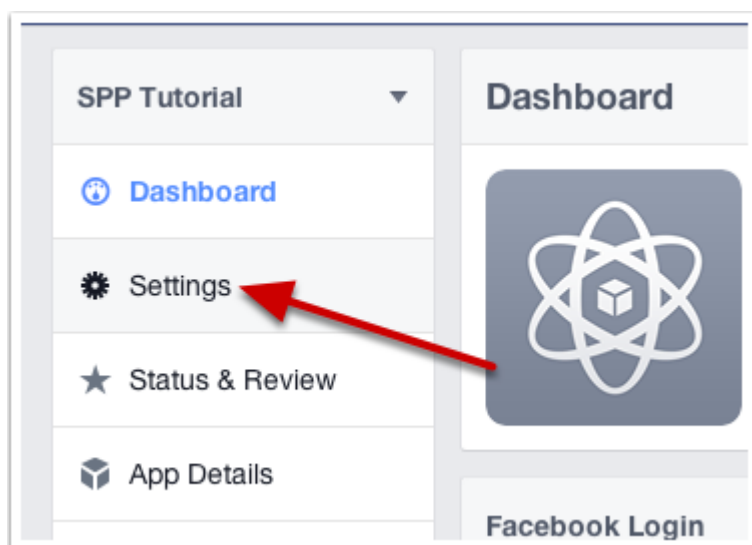
Get Your App ID

Your app is now created successfully. Before you move on, grab the App ID and copy it to a safe place. You will need it for your plugin.




Authorize Your Website





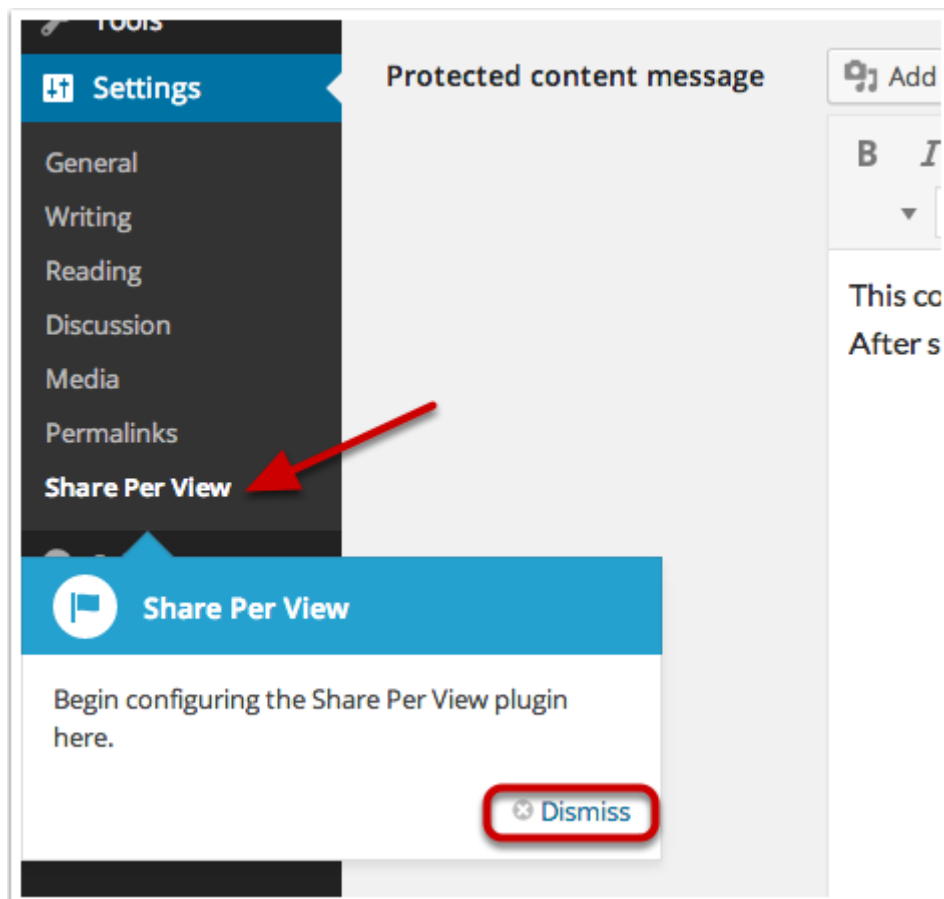
In the Site URL field, enter the URL to your website, then Save Changes


Configure The Plugin

Go to Settings >> Share Per View in your WordPress site. There is a pointer popup to help you locate this as well. You can dismiss it when you're done.



Edit Protected Content Message

This short bit of content will replace the content you want to hide. It tells people what to do in order to access the content. A default suggestion is already added for you. Edit if you need to.

Edit The Default Tweet

When someone chooses to share via Twitter, you can automatically pre-fill their tweet. A default is added for you. Edit if necessary.

Cookies

The plugin uses cookies to help track who has or hasn't shared your content. The default is 30 days. Change this to the number of days you think is best. You must enter numbers only.

Hiding Entire Post

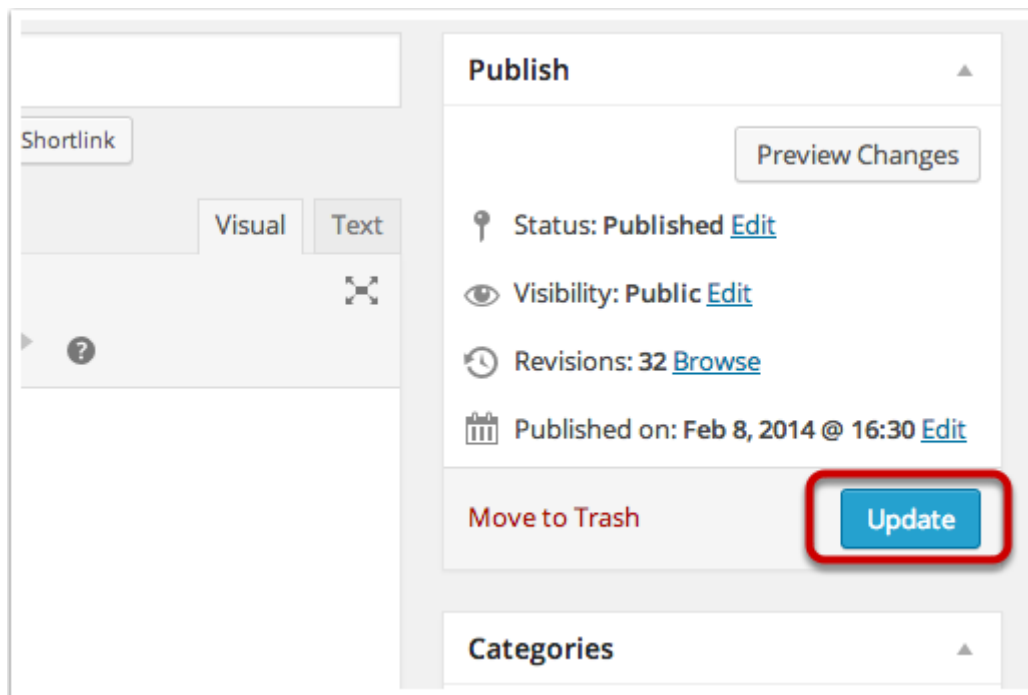
The plugin gives you two options to hide your content. Entire post (only) or partial post.

1. Here, we are opting to hide the entire post.
2. If you wish to, you can customize the protected content message for this post. This overrides the default settings earlier.
3. If you wish to, you can customize the tweet for this post. This overrides the default settings earlier.
4. If you wish to, you can customize your Twitter ID for this post. This overrides the default settings earlier.

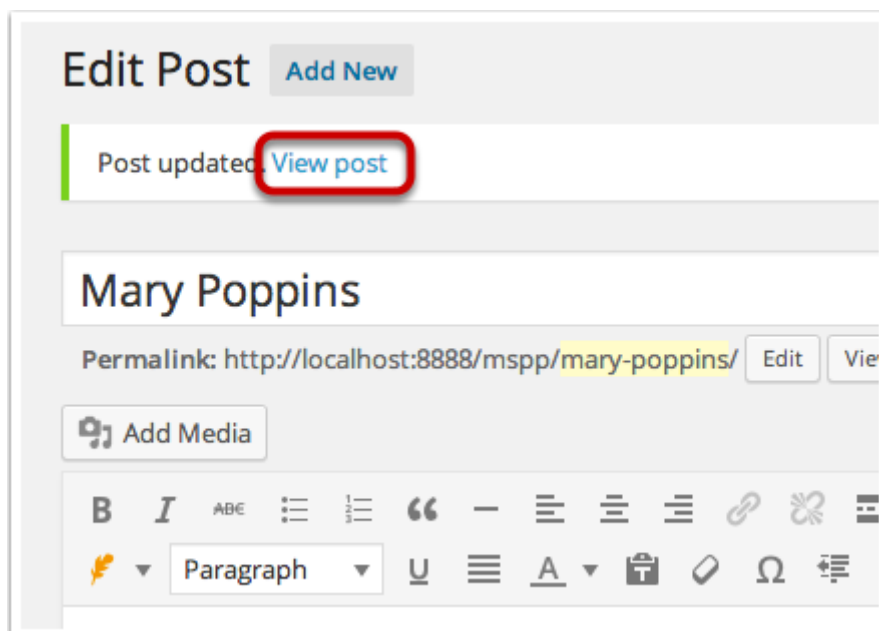
Update or Publish Your Post

When you are done, save, update or publish your post.



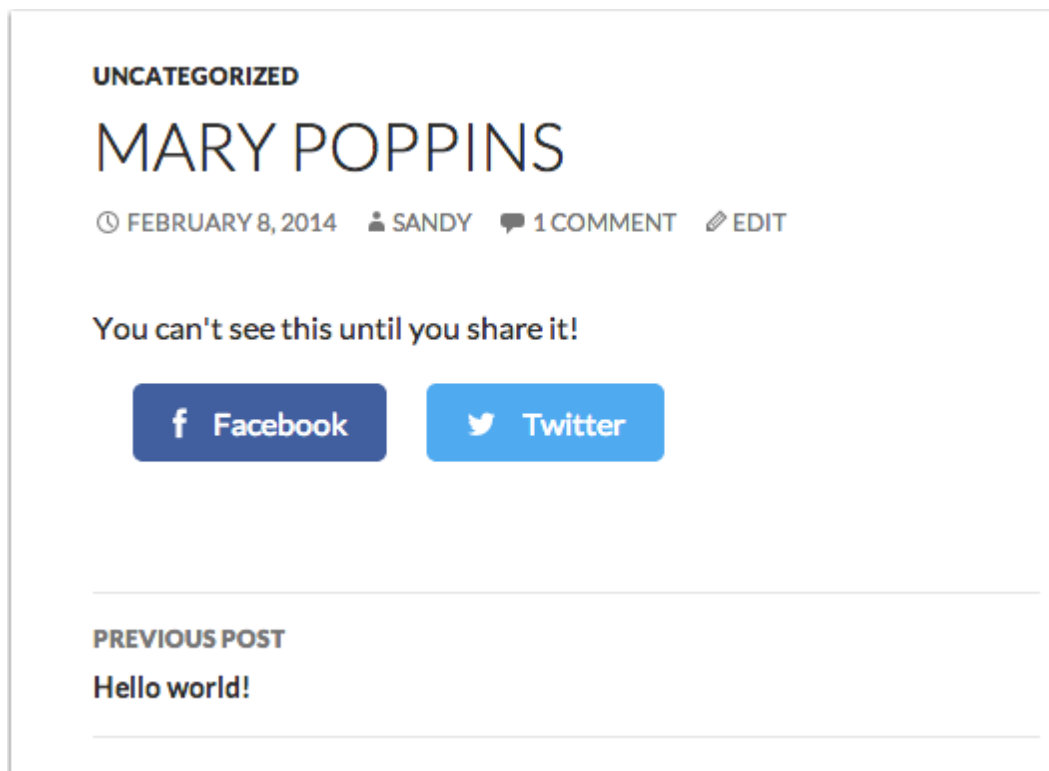
View Post

After saving successfully, click the view the post.



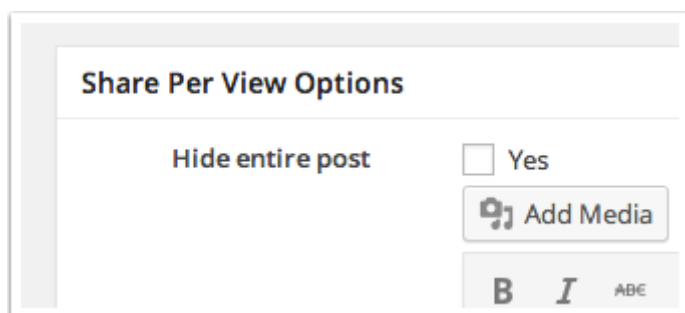
Post Is Hidden

Your entire post is now hidden. In its place is the custom content you entered and the buttons required to share. Clicking on either button loads a popup for sharing. Immediately after sharing, the page will refresh to reveal your content. If the page does not refresh, or you don't see the content, check your browser settings. If cookies are turned off, this plugin won't work.



Hiding Partial Content

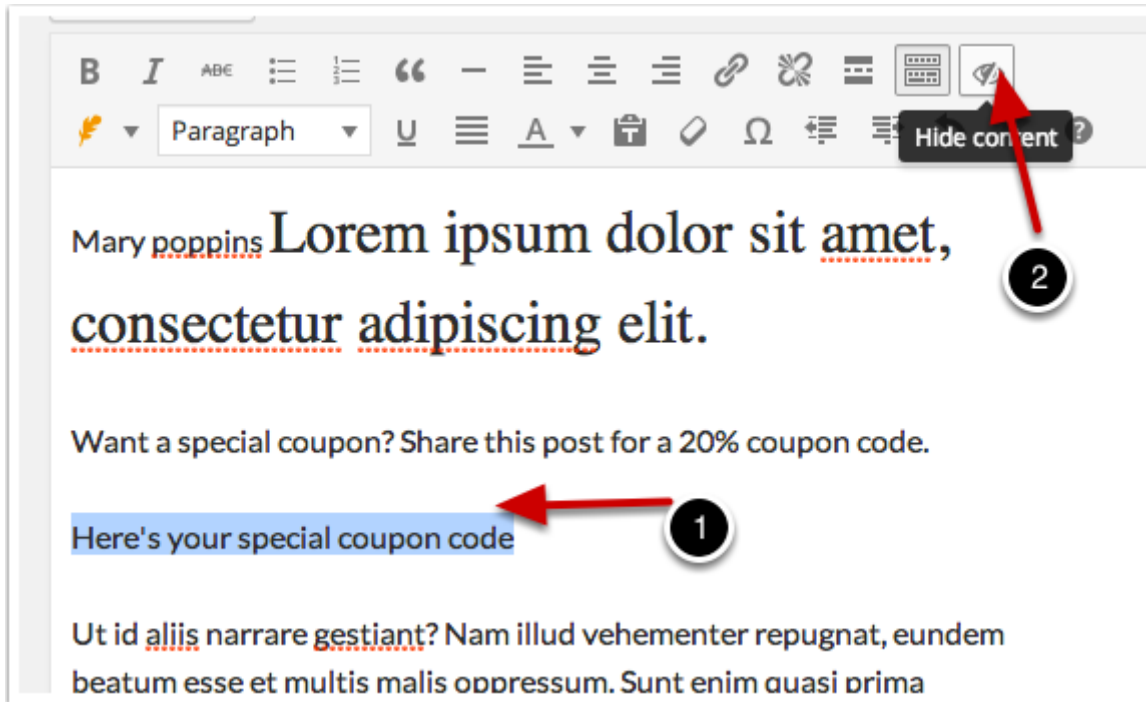
To hide only part of the post on this page instead of the entire post, uncheck the Hide entire post option.



Define Content To Hide

You must now tell the plugin which portion of the content in the post you wish to hide. Using the visual editor,

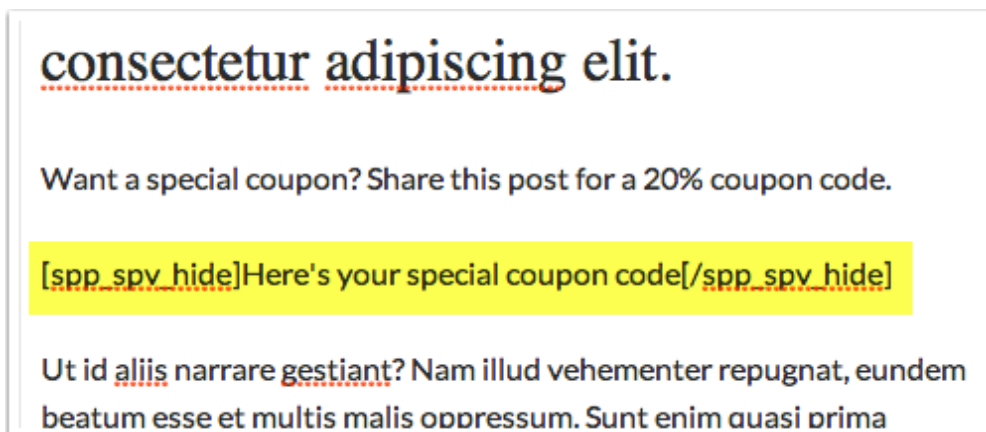
1. Select the content you want to hide.
2. Click the Hide Content button in the editor.



Content Enclosed by Shortcode

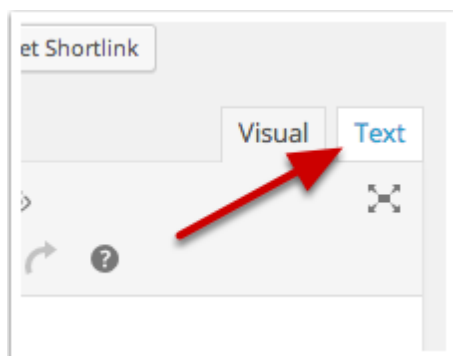
Your content should then be enclosed with the necessary shortcode like this.

Important! If you later change your mind and want to protect the entire post, be sure to remove shortcodes. Otherwise, parts of your post will still be visible.



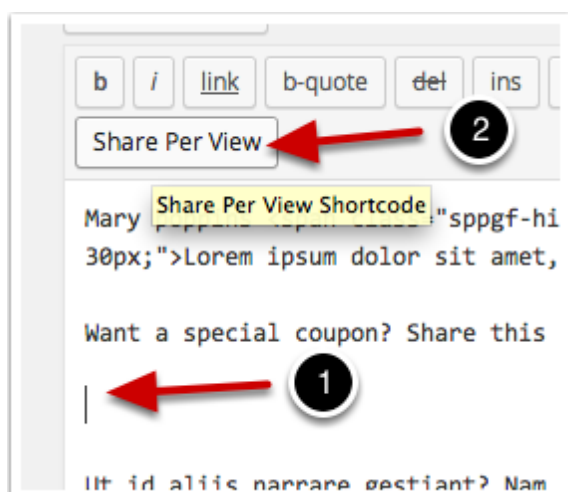
Define Content To Hide In Text Editor

You can also add the shortcode in the Text editor



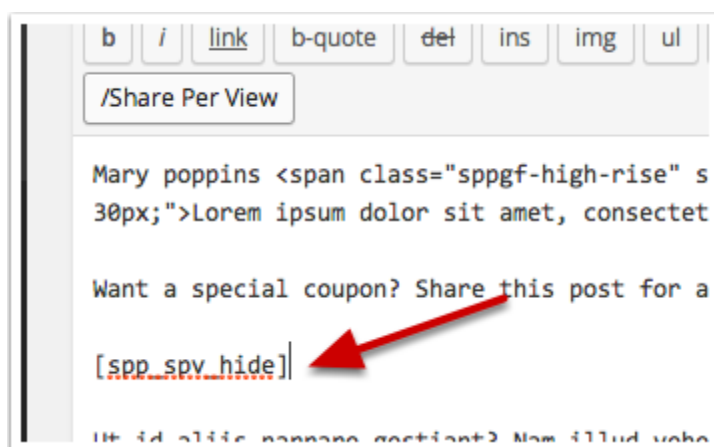
Position Your Cursor

1. Position your cursor where the hidden content should begin.
2. Click the Share Per View button.



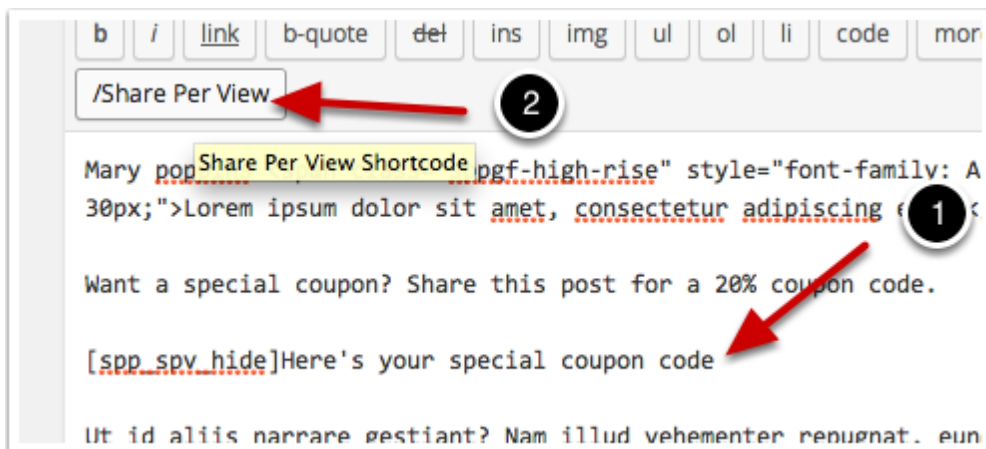
Enter Your Content

The first part of the shortcode would be entered into the editor. Proceed to add your content after the shortcode.



Close The Shortcode

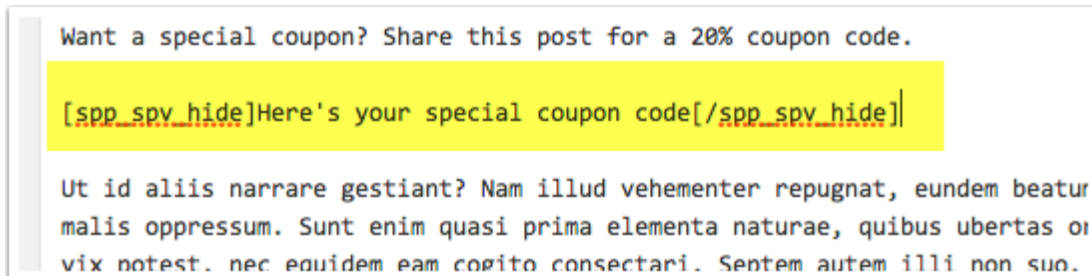
1. After entering your content, position your cursor at the end of the content.
2. Click the /Share Per View button to close the shortcode.



Content To Hide

The content you want to hide should be enclosed like this.

Important! If you later change your mind and want to protect the entire post, be sure to remove shortcodes. Otherwise, parts of your post will still be visible.



Review Your Post

When you view your post now, you will see only the portion you selected is hidden, replaced by the buttons. The rest of your content remains intact.

Clicking on either button loads a popup for sharing. Immediately after sharing, the page will refresh to reveal your content. If the page does not refresh, or you don't see the content, check your browser settings. If cookies are turned off, this plugin won't work.
