- Pillows made from toile fabric

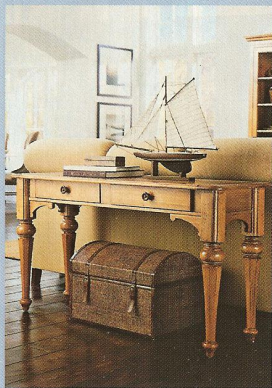
