

Position Title: Woodmen Heights (WH) Early Childhood Assistant

Hours/week: 20 hours/week (Part-time)

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Helps oversee all aspects of Early Childhood Ministries and ensure consistent quality at each service time for Early Childhood Ministries; maintains regular communication with Division Leaders (DLs) and Ministry Partners (MPs)
- 2. Builds community with WH Early Childhood families
- 3. Part of Woodmen Kids team, initiating/implementing ideas/updating programs; participates with program/event development
- 4. Helps coordinates with Access (special needs) Ministries on the WH Campus
- 5. Participates in organization and plans of special events and supplemental programming under supervision of WH Early Childhood
- 6. Supports administration for weekend services
- 7. Helps oversees teaching on weekends; assists with teaching supplemental/special classes as needed
- 8. Assists in recruiting and onboarding of WH Kids MPs
- 9. Helps work with Facilities Team to ensure facilities are safe for children
- 10. Mandatory reporter/advocate for children; keeps WH Early Childhood informed of situation(s)
- 11. Maintains specified, yet flexible weekly office hours
- 12. Other duties as assigned
