
On this day, the Honorable Margaret L. Workman, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia, as well as Justice Robin Jean Davis, Justice Menis E. Ketchum, Justice Allen H. Loughry II, and Justice Elizabeth D. Walker, have advised the Clerk of the Court that they have voluntarily recused themselves from participating in the above-captioned case.


Pursuant to the Supreme Court Rules of Appellate Procedure and the Rule of Necessity, Chief Justice Workman appoints the Honorable Joanna I. Tabit, Judge of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, to be the acting Chief Justice in the above-captioned case and directs that Judge Tabit shall appoint four acting justices to preside with her in this case.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, that the Honorable Joanna I. Tabit, Judge of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, be, and she hereby is, assigned to the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia, as the acting Chief Justice, under the provisions of Article VIII, § 2 of the Constitution of West Virginia in the above-captioned case. It is further ORDERED that acting Chief Justice Tabit shall appoint four other acting justices to preside with her in the above-captioned case; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia record this Order in the Office of said Clerk and that proceedings be held in the manner provided by law.
