Consumers who had a report prepared on them by Credco Corelogic, LLC may be affected by a class action settlement.

You may be entitled to a payment ranging from \$150-\$2,500.

Your rights and options are explained in this notice. Please read this notice carefully. Full information regarding the settlement is available at [INSERT WEBSITE](#).

You are receiving this notice because you have been identified as a class member in a class action lawsuit entitled which alleges that Corelogic Credco, LLC (“Credco”) violated the Fair Credit Reporting Act (“FCRA”) by inaccurately indicating in an OFAC Report that consumers may be a possible match to entries on the Office of Foreign Asset Control’s (“OFAC”) list of Specially Designated Nationals. The lawsuit further alleges that Credco failed to disclose reported OFAC information and information about entities that requested Credco reports in response to consumer requests.

Credco denies any and all allegations or assertions of wrongdoing in this lawsuit, and denies any and all allegations or assertions that it is liable to Plaintiff or any member of the Settlement Classes. The Court has not made any finding that Defendant has engaged in any wrongdoing or misconduct of any kind, or is liable in any way, including regarding Plaintiff’s alleged violations of the FCRA. Defendant has, however, agreed to settle the lawsuit so that it may, among other things, avoid additional litigation burdens and expenses.

The parties have reached a proposed settlement in the lawsuit. The settlement has not been approved by the Court yet. This notice explains your options. You may have to submit a claim form to receive a payment. You may submit a claim form online at [INSERT WEBSITE](#).

Am I Included in the Settlement?

There are three classes of people included in the settlement. According to Credco’s records, you are a member of the <<[INSERT CLASSES](#)>>.

- **Inaccurate Reporting Class:** All individuals who were the subject of an OFAC Report that Credco disseminated to a third party from June 3, 2013 through August 28, 2023, where the OFAC Report reported at least one hit, match, possible match, or “record for review.”
- **Failure to Disclose Class:** All individuals (i) who were the subject of an OFAC Report that Credco disseminated to a third party from June 3, 2015 through August 28, 2023, where the OFAC Report reported at least one hit, match, possible match, or “record for review”; and (ii) who made a request to Defendant for their consumer file or report after such OFAC Report had been disseminated.

- **Failure to Identify Class:** All individuals who, from June 3, 2015 to June 30, 2021, made a request to Credco and to whom Credco provided a consumer file disclosure.

How Do I Receive a Payment

The settlement establishes a \$58,500,000 Settlement Fund for payments to Class Members, attorneys' fees, costs, settlement administration, and any approved Class Representative award. Payments to class members are tied to class membership. If you are a member of all three classes, you will be entitled to the payments associated with each class.

Each member of the **Failure to Identify Class** will receive \$500. Each member of the **Failure to Disclose Class** will receive \$1,000. If you are a member of both of these Classes, you will receive \$1,500. To receive a payment for these Classes, you do not need to submit a claim form. Please ensure that your address is up to date and if you would like to receive an electronic payment instead of a check, please go to the settlement website, and provide your payment information.

If you are a member of the **Inaccurate Reporting Class**, you are required to submit a claim to receive the payment associated with that Class. A claim form can be submitted on the settlement website, [LINK](#). Payments will depend on the number of claims submitted, among other things, but are estimated to range from approximately \$150-\$1,000.

What Are My Other Options?

(1) Do Nothing. If you do nothing in response to this Notice, you will receive a monetary payment if you are a member of the **Failure to Disclose** or **Failure to Identify Class**. If you are only a member of the **Inaccurate Reporting Class** and do nothing, you will not receive any payment. You will lose any legal rights you may have against Credco both related to this suit and to object to the Settlement of this suit.

(2) Exclude Yourself. You may exclude yourself from the Settlement Classes by mailing a written notice to the Settlement Administrator postmarked by [xxxxxx](#), that includes a signed and dated statement you want to be excluded from the Classes. If you exclude yourself, you will not receive a settlement payment, but you retain any legal rights you may have against Credco.

(3) Object. If you do not exclude yourself, you and/or your lawyer have the right to appear before the Court and object to the Settlement. Your written, signed objection must be provided to the Settlement Administrator and filed with the Court, no later than [xxxxxx](#).

Who Represents Me?

The Court has appointed lawyers from Berger Montague PC to serve as Class Counsel. They will petition to be paid legal fees not to exceed 25% of the Settlement Fund, out of pocket costs, as well as request a Class Representative Award not to exceed \$20,000, and settlement administration expenses to be paid from the settlement fund.

When Will the Court Consider the Settlement?

The Court will hold a final approval hearing on **DATE**, at **TIME**. At that hearing, the Court will hear any objections concerning the fairness of the Settlement, decide whether to approve the requested attorneys' fees and costs, Class Representative award, and determine whether the Settlement should be approved.
