## INTRODUCTION

- Exodus 13:17-18, "...God led them along a route through the wilderness toward the Red Sea..."
- We are all on the journey with Jesus.

## I. THE JOURNEY

- Seemed like a dead end...but it was really a positioning for God to receive glory.
- The Pillar Of Cloud:
  1. This pillar was identified with the Angel of the Lord who led the nation (14:19; 23:20-23)
    - *"And the angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel..."*
  2. This is called a Theophany...it is Jesus!
  3. God does the same for you today...He has sent His Son and got your back and front.
  4. He protects and provides...especially when things get tough.

## II. THE COVERING

- Spirit of God is always covering the journey, if you are trusting Him.
- Romans 8:28, "...God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose."

- Heart\_of WOL - To trust God to lead us even if and when we don't fully understand.
- Exodus 13:21-22 - God says two things - Trust Me, I care for you and follow Me, I will lead you.
- He now lives in us to protect and guide.

## III. THE CUL-DE-SAC

- Exodus 14:1-3, "...the Lord spoke...'tell the sons of Israel to turn back and camp before Pi-Hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea..."
- Vs. 4, "...and they did so." They did obey.
- God led them right into a cul-de-sac.
- God will allow you to be found in very difficult circumstances.
- This is where He works, both in us and through us.
- To trust Him... and then He will press us.
- God intentionally directed Israel into a cul-de-sac at the Red Sea in order to display His power.

## CLOSE

- All journeys have two things God sets before us - obedience and sacrifice.
- God always provides the sacrifice and then asks us to obey and give it.
- John 3:16, "...who so ever believes in Him..."
