I. FINDING SUCCESS IN YOUR JOURNEY

- What is the strategy for success in the journey?
- It always has to do with faith...always!
- Hebrews 11:24-27, "By faith Moses...persevered because he saw Him who is invisible."
- Believing what you cannot see - Moses saw Jesus!
- When the going gets tough, keep your eyes on Jesus not on your circumstances.

II. THERE ARE GIANTS IN THE PROMISED LAND

- Numbers 13:1-2, "Then the Lord spoke to Moses ...send out...men...spy out the land of Canaan..."
- Vs. 25-28, "...nevertheless, the people who live in the land are strong...we saw the descendants of Anak there."
- One word there that needs underlining - "nevertheless."
- God kept His word, the land was as He described.
- But! He forgot to tell us there were giants!
- Did God "forget" to tell them about the giants? No
- The biggest place many of us have giants is in our hearts!
- Your destiny will be full of promise and giants.

III. WHERE IS YOUR EYE FIXED?

- Two responses here - faith and unbelief.
- Vs. 30 - Caleb speaks faith, "We shall surely overcome it."
- Vs. 31-32 - unbelief, "It will devour us."
- Vs. 33 - "We saw giants...and we became like grasshoppers."
- Grasshoppers - How many of us are grasshoppers when it comes to entering into His promises?
- Fix your eyes on Jesus and He will be big in you, fix your eyes on circumstances and you will live like a grasshopper!

IV. NO PROMISE WITHOUT RISK

- Your promise (land) will always have risk.
- Do you see the opposition or the opportunity?
- Take a risk.
- Exodus 35:20 & 22, "...everyone...whose heart moved him brought an offering."
- "Not equal giving, but equal sacrifice."
- II Corinthians 9:8 is clear, God wants to provide for you so you can bless others.
- Real faith must take on action.
- Recognizing other's needs and meeting them is how Jesus lived His whole life.
- Vs. 6-7, "...he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly...not grudgingly or under compulsion..."
- Paul said this to free them from fear in giving.
- We all deal with the fear of insufficiency.
- The promise that God is able is linked to a cheerful heart, not to fear.
