

**THE REVELATION OF JESUS PART VII**  
**REVELATION 10-11**  
**OCTOBER 19-20, 2019**

**INTRODUCTION**

- Last week in Revelation 7, had a view of eternity and heaven; the 144,000, the rapture, Jesus' 2<sup>nd</sup> coming.
- Chapters 8-9 are the trumpet judgments.
- Revelation 10:5-7, "Then the angel whom I saw...swore by Him who lives forever and ever...that there will be delay no longer, <sup>7</sup>but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of God is finished, as He preached to His servants the prophets."
- Vs. 10:7 - The days of the voice of the 7<sup>th</sup> angel - culmination of all time. A period of time coming to an end.
- Vs. 7 - "The mystery of God" has to do with the 144,000 found in chapters 7 and 14.

**I. ANGELS, ANGELS, ANGELS**

- Revelation 10:1 - "A strong angel" who is this?
- This messenger or angelos?
- There are angels all over the book of Revelation? Over 70 times
- John saw angels all over heaven; some do appear as people.
- Hebrews 13:2, "...entertained angels without knowing it."

**II. THE KINGDOM COMES**

- End vs. 6 - "delay no longer"
- Vs. 10:7 - 7<sup>th</sup> angel about to sound
- Vs. 11:15 - 7<sup>th</sup> angel sounded
- These are the keys to these two chapters.

- This is the culmination of all time.
- Vss. 8-9 - Take the book, eat it! Psalm 119:103
- Eating the gospel is good, sweet, but to give it out to others can be very costly and tough.
- Tastes good, but it can be bitter to share with others!  
The two witnesses in Chapter 11.

**III. THE BEAST AND THE TWO WITNESSES**

- The three most difficult people to identify in Revelation are the 144,000, the beast and the two witnesses.
- Is it symbolic or literal? Probably both.
- Chapter 11 - I believe is about our call to outreach, telling people about Jesus.
- And persecution - vss. 2-13
- The two witnesses represent a light in darkness, a witness to the world.

**IV. RESTORING THE KINGDOM**

- Revelation 11:15, "...The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ..."
- This is the message of the Bible, the kingdom of God.
- Dominant theme occurs 100 times. Jesus uses the word over 150 times.
- Matthew 6:10, "Thy kingdom come..."
- God sent His Son to restore both rulership and relationship.

**CLOSE**

- Loss of the kingdom = destruction - disorder - dominion - relationship
- The restoration of the kingdom means, healing, order, life and possibility.
