**INTRODUCTION**

- Who do you worship?
- Revelation 19:1b, After this, I heard what sounded like a vast crowd in heaven shouting, “Praise the Lord! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God.”

**I. THE SOUL OF REVELATION**

- Revelation is apocalyptic literature = Revealing
- Revelation illustrates the conflict of the kingdom of darkness and the Kingdom of Light.
- Shows us what we are created to do in this life; Worship.
- It is an image of worship and warfare.
- It shows us that worship isn't something we do, it is part of who we are.
- Revelation 19:5-6, “...‘Praise our God, all His servants...from the least to the greatest.’...”

**II. WHO WE ARE**

- Worship is less something we do, it is more who we are called to be (priests).
- It is how you handle your time, how you serve.
- Vss. 1-6 - Shows us the world being restored and our place in it, worshipping.
- Jesus receiving praise from all creation.

**III. THE CHURCH**

- Vss. 7-10 - Speak to the Church preparing for her destiny.

- Revelation 19:7-9, “...the wedding feast of the Lamb, and His bride has prepared herself...the fine linen represents the good deeds of God’s holy people...”
- Vs. 8 is key - The Church (Bride) is dressed (NASB) “in fine linen...represents the righteous acts of the saints.”
- What we do in this life partners with and builds the kingdom of God in us and around us or it doesn’t.
- Ephesians 2:8-9 - We are saved by grace, but clothed or seen in the light of our right living.

**IV. LIVING RIGHT**

- Revelation 19:11-21:3 describes the coming of Jesus and the defeat of His enemies.
- Jesus going to battle with darkness is a reminder that He has and is still fighting for us.
- Right living puts us right with God and others.
- Righteousness is God’s grace empowering us to live right.
- Revelation is a picture of what He wants to do inside of us; overcome darkness and deliver us to the light.

**V. REVEALING**

- Revelation’s core purpose is to reveal hope through a powerful image of God as the Lord of all history and His redemptive activity in Jesus.
- In the end Revelation is a portrait of Eden being corrected.

**CLOSE**

- Revelation 19 is all about worship. Worship that follows the light overcoming the dark.
- Key to all of Revelation is that Jesus is the King and He already won.
