- Integrity Proverbs 10:9, "Whoever walks in <u>integrity</u> walks securely..."
- Shema Deuteronomy 6:4-9, "...Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength...Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up..."
- II Timothy 2:2 <u>Daily</u> lifestyle.
- The goal for all of us is to impart life to our children, how?
- Live your life daily with your children, make <u>sacrifices</u> and talk to them. Worship in your home.

I. WATCHING YOUR CHILDREN LOSE THEIR FAITH

- Why do adult children walk away from faith?
- Six reasons our children's faith atrophies:
 - 1st Neglect spiritual disciplines.
 - 2nd Drifting is slow and often unseen at first.
 - 3rd Unbelief or lack of trust.

- 4th Disobedience or an act of our will against God. John 14:21 NLT, Jesus said "Those who accept my commandments and obey them...love Me."
- 5th Hardening our hearts towards God.
- 6th Forfeiting our spiritual destiny.

II. WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- Remain <u>graceful</u> not harsh, love them and don't lecture.
- Look for opportunities to input thoughtfully.
- Let them reap what they have sown, don't <u>rescue</u> them.
- Refuse to beat yourself up. Release your children to Him.
- Pray for them, <u>fast and pray</u> and live your life with a full commitment to Jesus and His way and will.
- Continue to <u>influence</u> them as much as possible.
- Luke 15:11-32, "...a man who had two sons. ¹² The younger one said... 'Father, give me my share of the estate.' So he divided his property... ¹³ "...the younger son...set off for a distant country and there squandered his wealth...he began to be in need. ¹⁵ So he...hired himself out to a citizen...who sent him to his fields to feed pigs. ¹⁶ He longed to fill his stomach with the pods that the pigs were eating, but no one gave him anything."
- It was the memory of his father's goodness that brought the boy to repentance Romans 2:4.
- Proverbs 22:6 NASB, "Train up a child in the way he should go, even when he is old he will not depart from it..."
