The West Virginia Development Office had previously approved a request for an Economic Infrastructure project loan of \$9 million to the City of Ranson, West Virginia to support the Rockwool project in Jefferson County, West Virginia.

The City of Ranson (the City) and the Charles Town Utility Board have requested that the \$9 million loan for this project be reassigned from the City to the Charles Town Utility Board. This is necessary due to the purchase of the Ranson system by the Charles Town Utility Board.

It is our recommendation that the Infrastructure and Jobs Development Council approve this loan reassignment. All other terms and conditions will remain the same.
