

Thank you for the opportunity to work with your child as a part of our **Mathnasium@Home** instruction option.

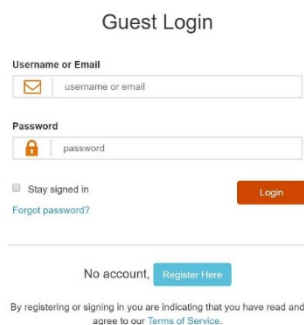
Prior to their first session, you will need to create a new password to login to your **@Home** sessions. Below are the steps involved in that process. You will also find details related to scheduling your sessions and logging into your sessions. Please note, the link to create your password and the link to login for your student's sessions are two separate links.

Creating Your ConexED Login

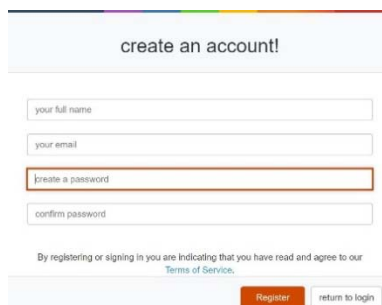
- 1 Connect to the ConexED log-in page clicking the URL below:

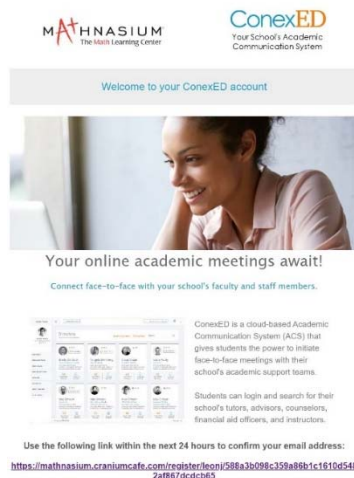
- 2 Click the **Register Here** button located at the bottom right corner.

- 3 Create an account by entering the correct information in the appropriate fields. We ask in the **Full Name** field that you enter your child's **first name followed by their last initial** to maintain your child's privacy. An email will be sent to the email you provided. A Gmail account is preferred but not required.

Connecting to ConexED for a Student Session

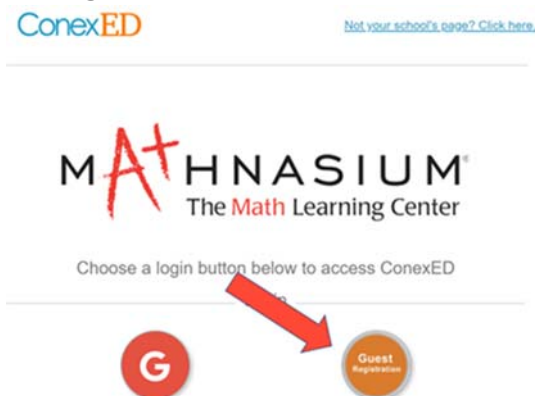
Once you have created your password, logging in for your sessions is very easy.

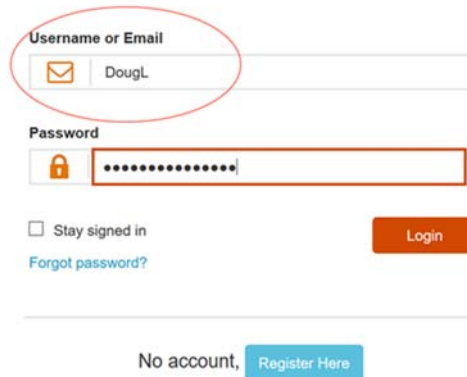

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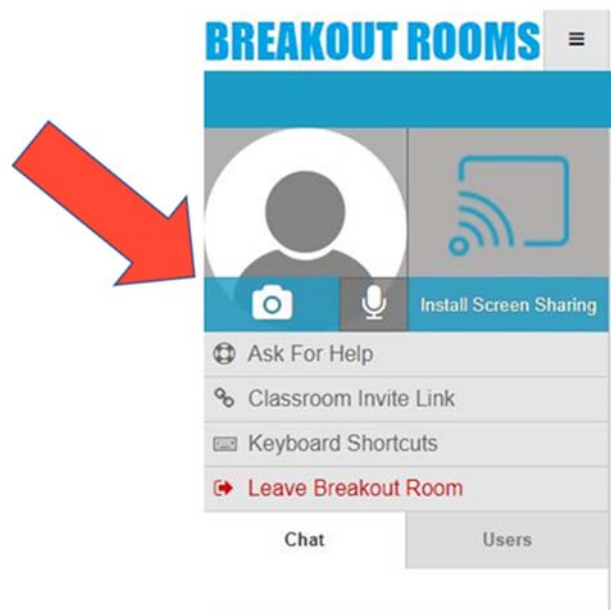

Scheduling Your @Home Sessions

To schedule your sessions, we have developed an online scheduling tool. Here's the link to the page on our website:

On this page, you'll find our online scheduling system. When you use it the first time, you'll go through it to schedule the session and at the end it will ask if you'd like to create an account. If you do that, in the future, you'll be able to have the info pre-populate or schedule multiple sessions, etc.

As all Nassau County Schools are temporarily closed, we will have afternoon sessions for the next 2 weeks on Wednesdays at **1PM-2PM, 2:15PM-3:15PM, 3:30PM-4:45PM**

- Note that the scheduling is a work in progress and will change over time as we evaluate the demand.
- There are only 3 open slots per hour (The @Home student instructor ratio will not exceed 3 to 1 at this time), so please schedule as soon as possible as we expect slots to close out quickly.

Tips for a Successful Instruction Experience

The following tips and suggestions are provided to maximize the benefits of your student's instruction via our Mathnasium **@Home** option. The recommended browser currently is Google Chrome.

Internet Connection

Ensure your computer has a solid internet connection. If your computer can be plugged directly into your home's modem, that will provide the fastest experience. However, a room with a solid wi-fi connection generally will be sufficient. Trying to connect from a coffee shop or other public wi-fi will negatively impact the experience.

Your Student's Set-Up

If possible, students should use headphones with a microphone. This will limit "echoing" and ensure the Instructor can properly hear the student and vice-versa. The student should be in a quiet area free from background distractions and noise.

Homework Help

If your student needs homework assistance, please ensure they have emailed a picture or PDF copy of it prior to their session so the Instructor can have it loaded into the program. The email address is:

Session Experience

- **@Home** sessions must be scheduled in advance. Your session must be scheduled at least three hours prior to the desired start time. Sessions are based on a “first come, first served” availability.
- You will receive a link via email that the student uses to log into their session. This link is good for all future sessions.
- If a student is late logging in, their session end time cannot be changed or extended.
- Please do not provide additional instruction or give students answers during their session. This may cause confusion for a student and impact their understanding of the material.
- The Instructor working with your student will be working with others. To ensure they provide the highest level of instruction for all Mathnasium Students, please contact the Center directly with any questions or other information that may need to be communicated. The Instructor will not be able to relay information or engage in conversations.
