

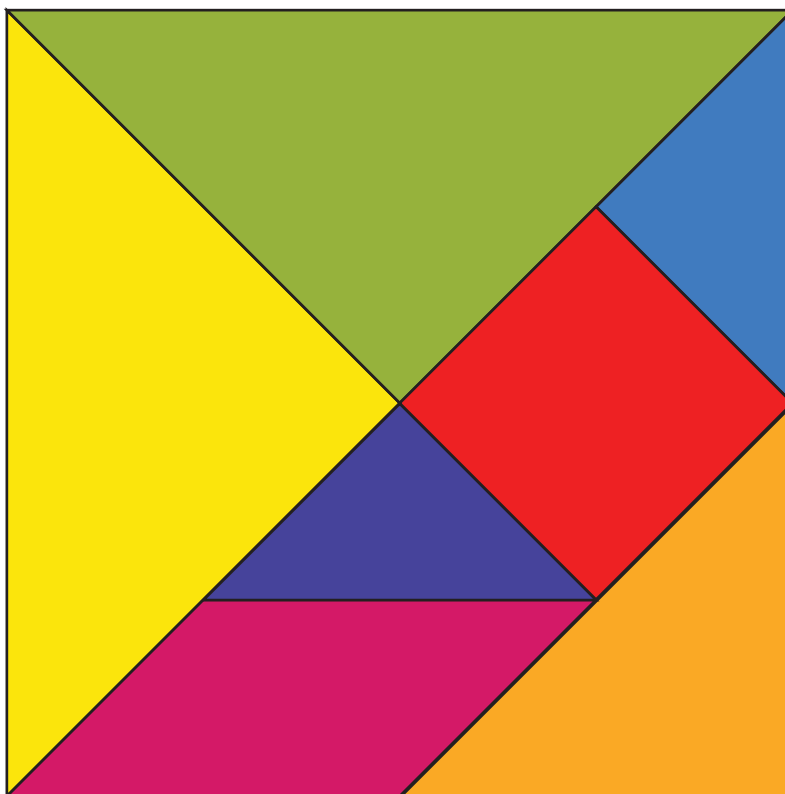


TANGRAMS



Cut out each shape below. Using your imagination and spatial reasoning skills, put all the pieces together to make fun figures! **Tip:** print them out on cardstock and laminate the pieces for a puzzle you can play with again and again.

Check out the sample images on page 2 of this packet to get a general idea of how tangrams work. Then, try assembling the pieces to form the six silhouettes included in this activity packet. To solve each puzzle, simply arrange all the pieces to form the silhouetted figure in such a way that all pieces touch without overlapping. When you're done, use your creativity and imagination to come up with figures of your own!

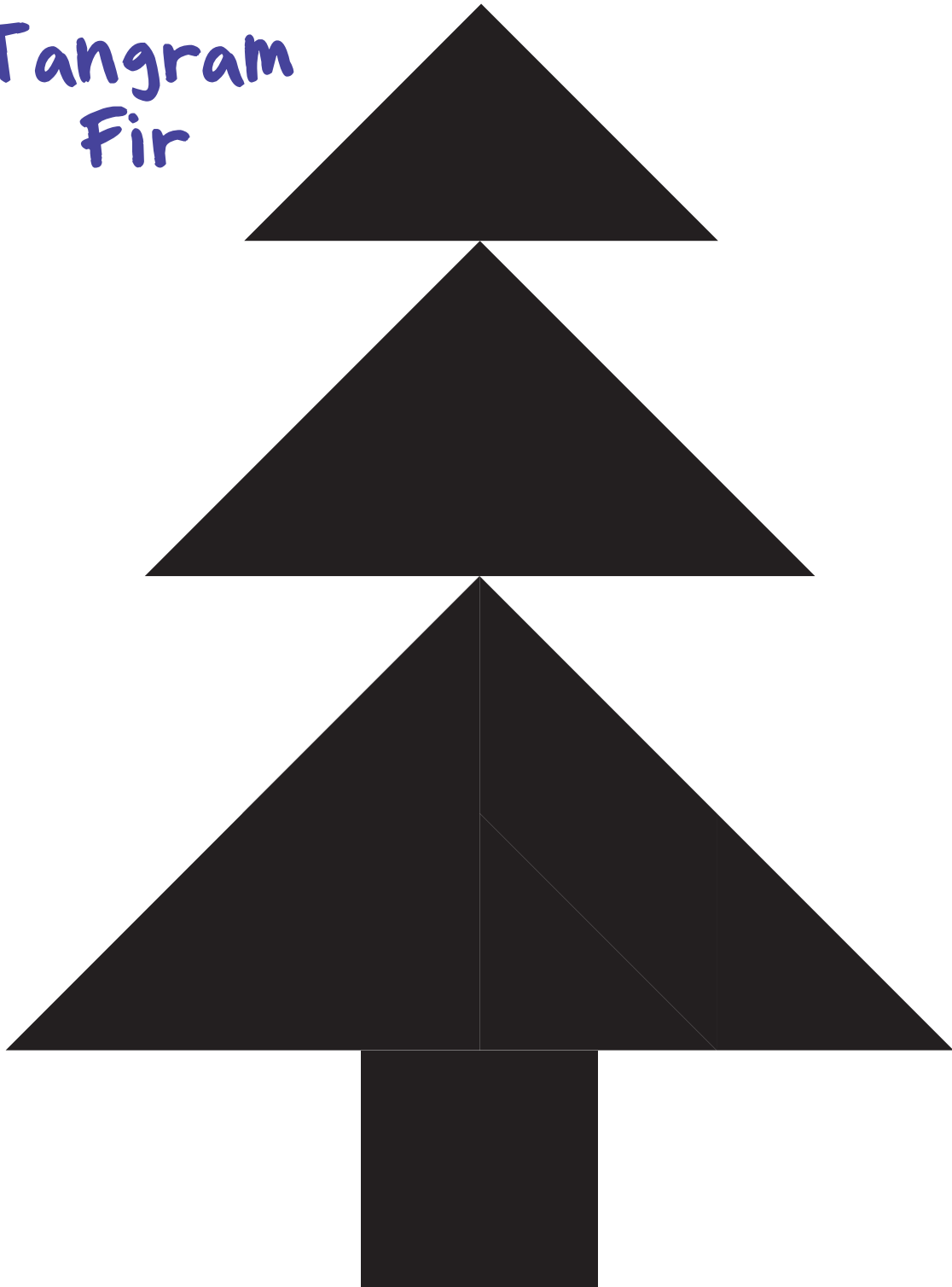

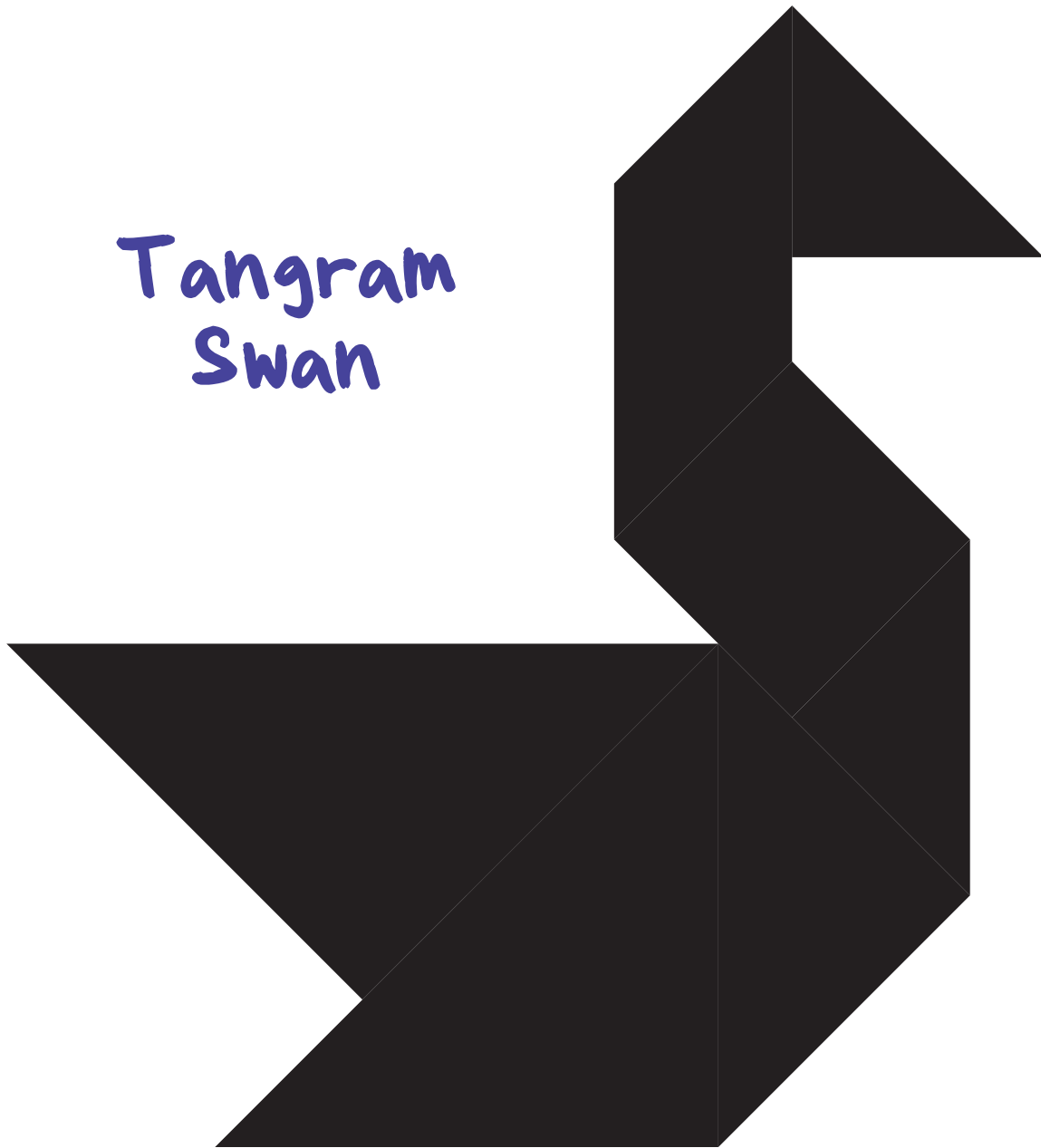
Tangram Examples

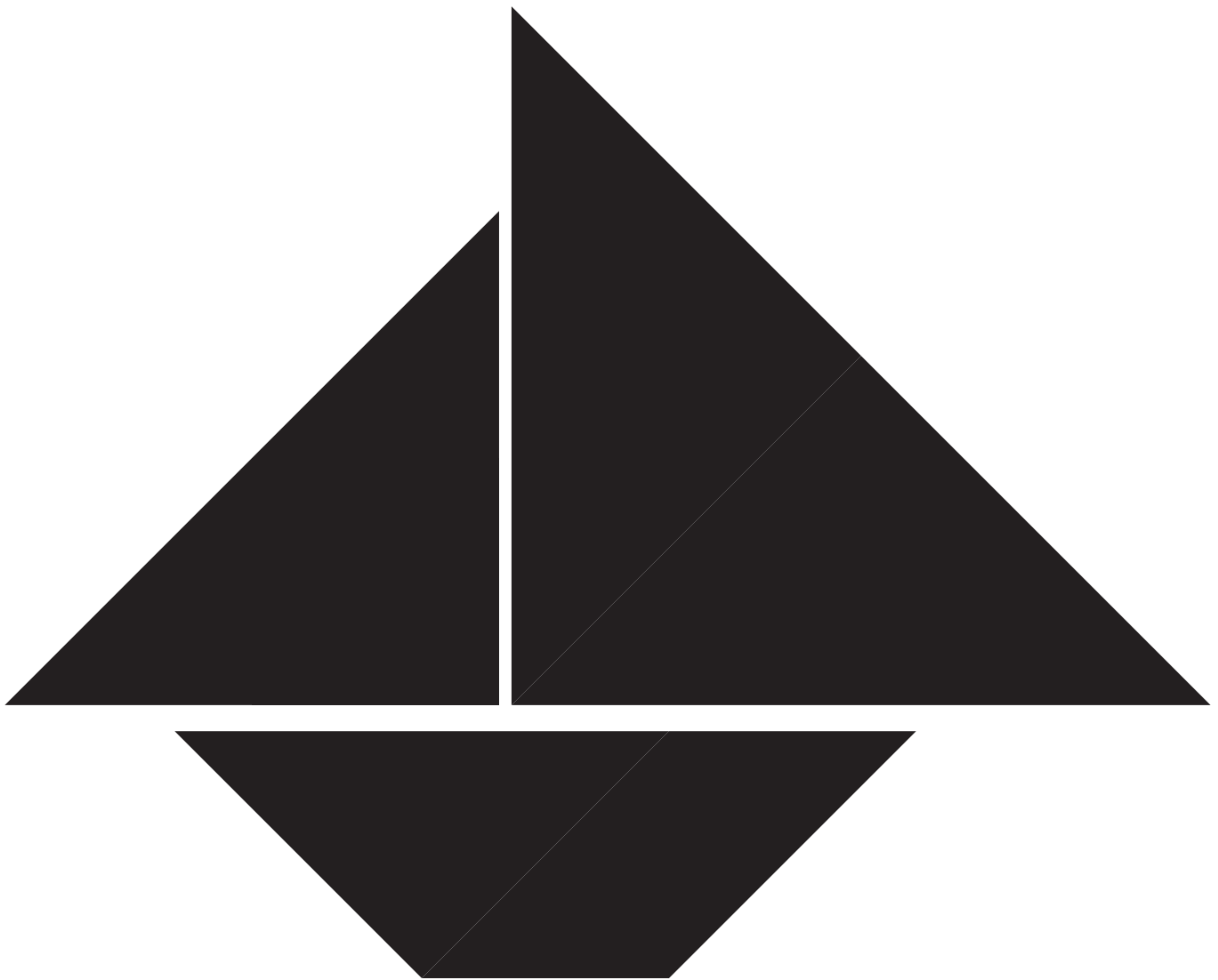
Tangram Fir



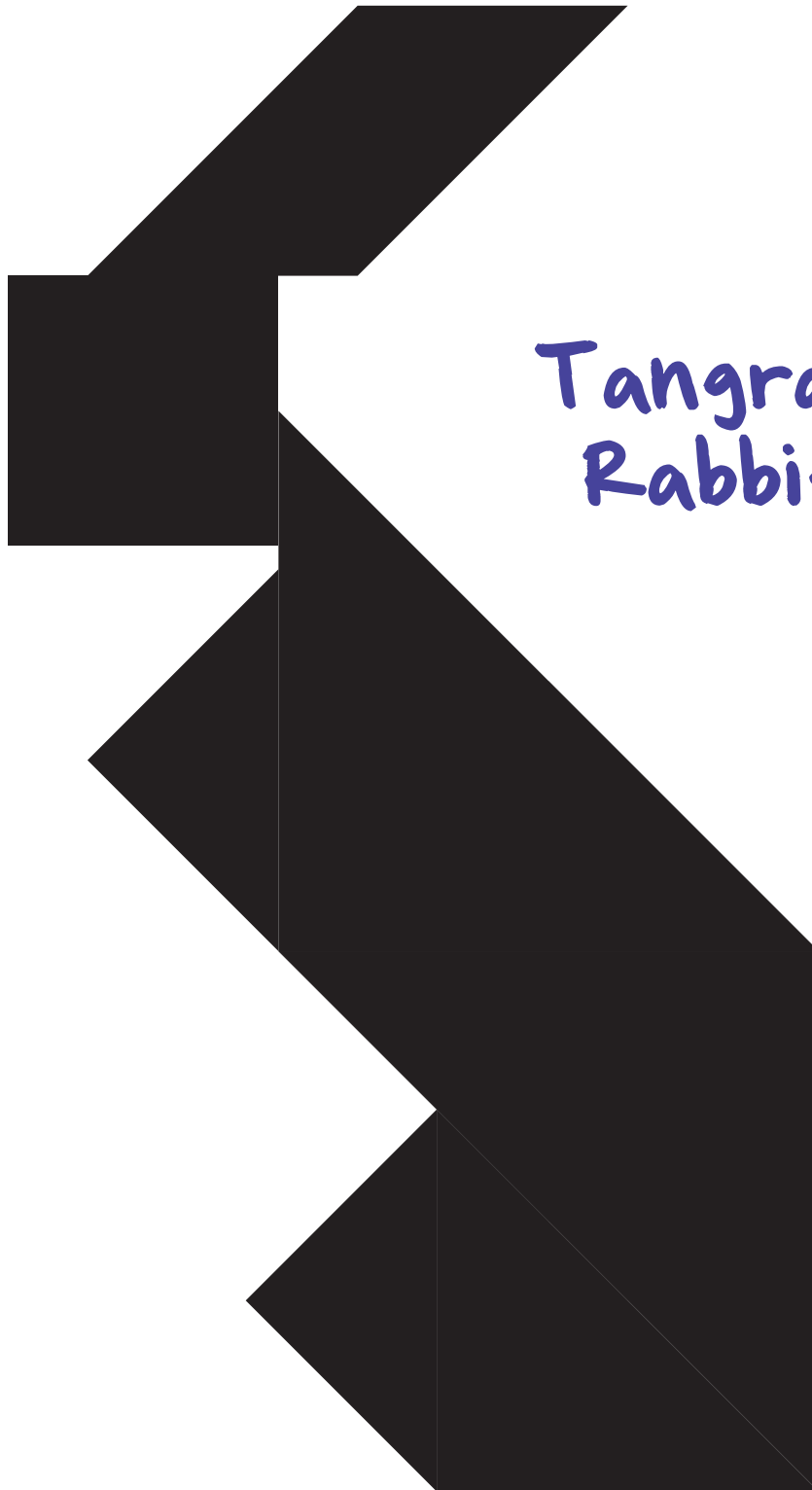
Tangram Swan
