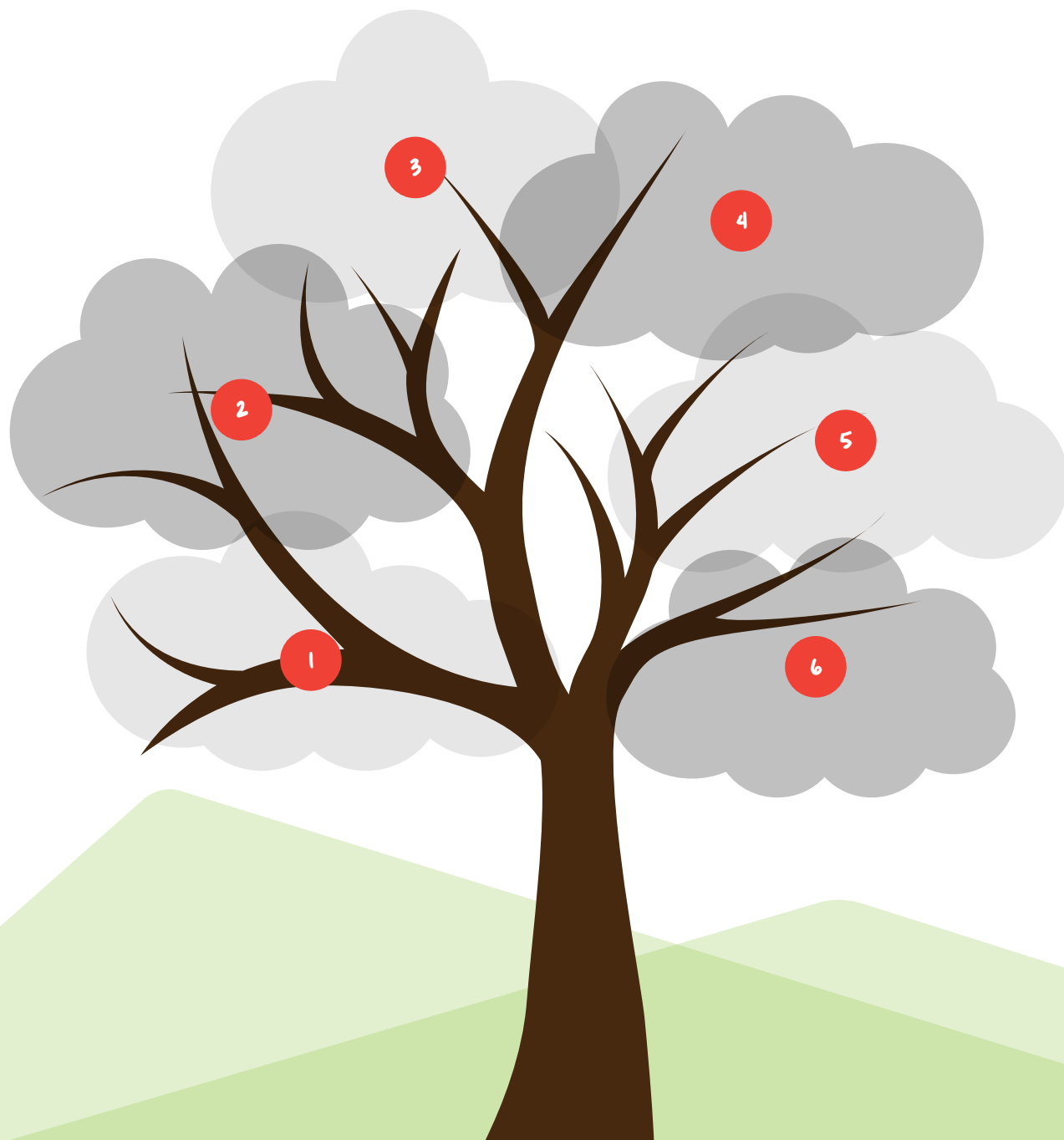


Math Takes Root

sequence in nature.



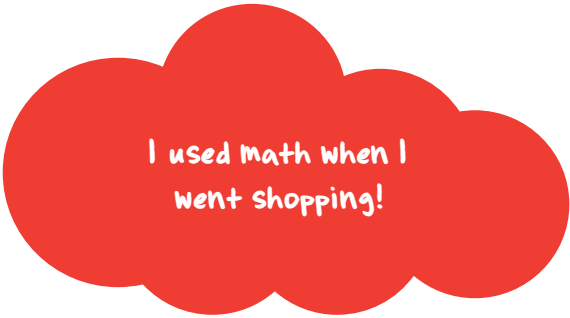
I used my creativity to

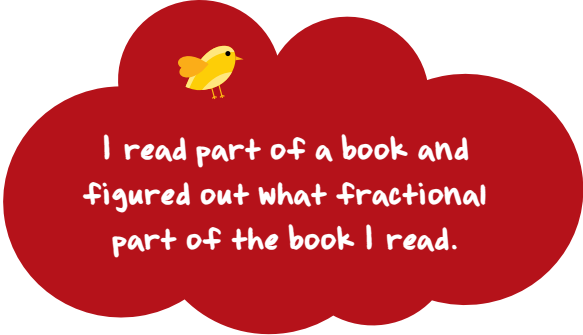


I used math to help my
family cook and/or bake.

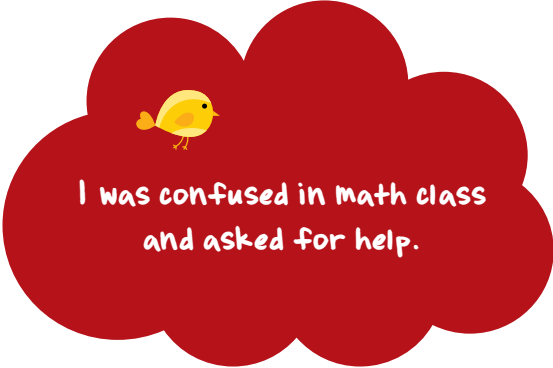
Math Activities

went shopping!



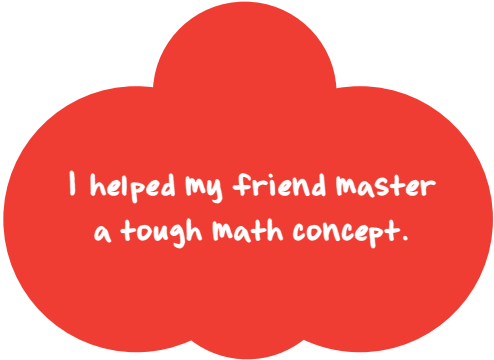
I read part of a book and
