Dr. Joyce Mills is a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist and founder of The StoryPlay Center in Scottsdale, Arizona. She is the author of seven books including *Therapeutic Metaphors for Children & the Child Within*. Through creative activities, storytelling, demonstrations, and case examples, Dr. Mills will show participants how to recognize, appreciate, and actualize the inner resources, gifts, and strengths of each client with whom they work as the *imaginal discs* for developing a relationship built on empowerment in a matter of minutes.

Additionally, participants will learn how to develop and utilize real life, made up, nature inspired and artistic metaphors along with *restorative steppingstones* to effect *transformational* healing and comfort for children, adolescents, adults and families who have experienced illness, trauma, grief, disaster, or loss; thereby, reawakening the "*resilient child within*."
